## Fr. Michael's Musings



In 1264, Pope Urban IV established this Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ because Holy Thursday, being so close to Good Friday, was

tinged with sadness. This Feast is given as a gift so that we might rejoice in the Eucharist with Sunday, Resurrection, Joy.

Years ago, as I was heading to Afghanistan, we had a layover in Kyrgyzstan, which seems about as far from South Dakota as one could get. I was nervous, a bit homesick, and uncertain about the months ahead. As I wandered the air field in this distant land, I found the base chapel and went inside.

There, just inside, was a sign saying, "The Blessed Sacrament is Reserved behind the Sanctuary." I went back there and found the beautiful wooden Tabernacle and the familiar red candle burning and knelt, smiling, as I told the Lord, "Everywhere I go, You always get there first."

The original tabernacle in Exodus was a tent, and that is still the meaning of the word. Tents were struck down and carried so that the people would always know God is with them. It is the same for us. God is always with us.

Holy Thursday may be touched by approaching sadness, but the gift is forever a gift of joy. Jesus gives us Himself, unites Himself to us. He is, in this Sacrament, truly Emmanuel: God With Us.

O Sacrament most Holy, O Sacrament Divine, all praise and all thanksgiving, be every moment Thine.
