

From the Deacon's Desk

In the living room of the priest residence at Saint Mary's there is a painting of a black dog with the caption, "True Friendship is a Gift From God." It reminds me of all the ways that God shows his love to us through His creatures that are our companions on earth. Fr. Michael has left me the responsibility to care for his dogs during his annual National Guard Training and I have the opportunity to experience friendship with creation in a whole new way these next two weeks. The dogs are faithful companions but I can tell that they miss their dear friend Fr Michael. I think they are a little lonely at times even though we take daily walks and keep up the normal routine of the day.

Loneliness is something that all of us experience during our life. I know that at different times I have missed friends and family who have become absent in my life due to distance or their passage into eternal life. Whenever I feel lonely I think of a story from the life of Venerable Matt Talbot whose cause for sainthood is underway. One day a women remarked to Matt that she was lonely and missed a cousin who had moved to a distant city. Matt Talbot replied that it was impossible for him to be lonely because he always was comforted by the presence of Jesus in the tabernacle. This brings to mind the old Irish poem and popular hymn, "What a friend we have in Jesus" which was written to comfort a mother by her son who moved across the Atlantic Ocean during the mid 1800's. This popular hymn reminds us that Christ brings meaning and comfort to our loneliness when we unite it to him in our prayer.

Our second reading this week reminds us that we are all one in Christ Jesus. No matter how far apart we are from our loved ones we can experience communion with them through our friendship with Christ. This Father's Day weekend we can celebrate the friendship we have with our Dad and give thanks to our Heavenly Father who sent us a friend who will always be our companion.
