

The dogs quickly sniff the ground, occasionally pausing for a second or two before resuming the search for new sights and smells. They provoked me to research how long an attention span the average human has - and the results are startling! According to a recent study, the average human attention span has fallen from twelve seconds in 2000, to eight seconds in 2015. Goldfish, meanwhile, are believed to have an attention span of nine seconds. That's right, the average human today has an attention span less than a goldfish. Researchers suspect that the increased usage of smart phones, tablets, and electronic devices has contributed to the decrease in our ability to stay focused.

These summer months afford us the opportunity to spend more time with family & friends. It is a great opportunity to share our lives with one another in a deeper way. I looked up to see the dogs staring back at me and I realized they probably thought "that Deacon sure does have a short attention span!"
