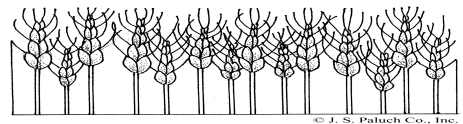
Pre-baptism class will be held next Tuesday, July 25 at 7 pm in the parish hall. Everyone must attend class before baptism is scheduled.
