Wow, it's hard to imagine that July is ending this week. I am amazed every year at how much faster summer goes by.

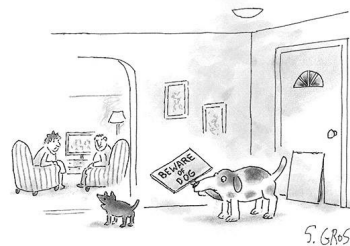
It seems just like yesterday that we had graduation and now Cavalier and Golden Eagle football players are getting ready for practice already (Vikings have already started...SKOL!!).
