This week I have been putting the finishing touches on a new workbench. This one doesn't replace my old oneit just stands beside it. As a woodworker, I

spend a lot of my time working in my shop building things for my shop. The first project I made was my toolbox, then my sawhorses, then the workbench and the list keeps going. Sometimes it seems that it is easier to build the tools that help me make projects than the projects themselves. I can get caught up in dreaming about how much easier work will be once I get the shop perfect, and lose the opportunities to just get things done.

I do not think that I am alone in this and I know that it isn't limited to woodworking. It is easy to dream about cooking in the perfect kitchen, or relaxing in the perfect yard or working at the perfect job and we loose sight on what we are called to do here and now. It can seem easier to live in our dreams than to live in our reality. We can't just dream, we need to act.

We can get caught in the same trap in our spiritual life. We can think that until we are perfect we cannot live out our faith. We can find ourselves not standing up for what we believe because we know that we fail to live it to the fullest sometimes. The Lord knows all of our faults and failings and he still calls us to act. We don't have to wait until we are perfect to live our faith, if we step out in faith the Lord will make up the difference.
