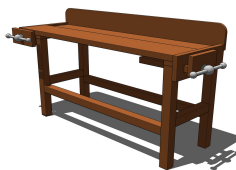

Sitting on the ancient foundations of a long gone building on a mountain overlooking the Jezreel Valley in northern Israel I could

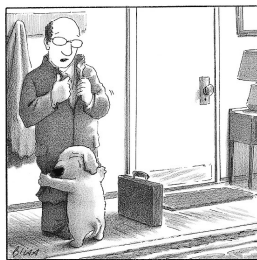
see why people have fought over that land for thousands of years; it was beautiful.

Before visiting the Holy Land I thought all of the middle east was desert, but as I looked down from the top of that mountain I saw large orchards and lush fields and my whole perspective of Israel changed.

I was sitting on the top of Mount Tabor, just outside of the church of the Transfiguration. I was on the same mountain that Jesus took his disciples up in the gospel this weekend. On that mountain Jesus gave those chosen disciples a glimpse of his divinity and their whole perspective of him changed. He was no longer just a teacher or a leader, in that instant he was revealed to be the Son of God.
