In the midst of all the events of this weekend, we also need to remember the 15th anniversary of the attack upon our nation on 9/11.

An awful lot has changed since the day that seems so long ago and so much like just yester-



We have been at war for so long now that there are students in our high schools who have never had a moment of life where we haven't been at war in Iraq and Afghanistan.

Brave men and women still die over there while we debate the next place to, euphemistically, put "boots on the
