It seems that for as long as people have been making things they have had workbenches to hold the projects at a comfortable height. Those heights change from culture to culture but they all have a flat space to work. There is a woodworking website that I follow that is doing work researching trends in workbenches through history. The most accurate depictions of benches for the past two thousand years have been found in images of St. Josephs workshop.

As artists through the ages have painted the Holy Family gathered in the workshop they have captured the details of their own age in the tools and fixtures they show. Often these images show Mary and Joseph working and Jesus either helping or watching intently, learning all of the things of this world that he came to save. The School of Nazareth is an idea the Pope Benedict talked about describing the early years of Jesus as a blessed time of learning from and loving his parents.

This week we resume our family education program here at St. Marys, I would like to thank all of the catechists that assist us in this process of handing on the faith.
