

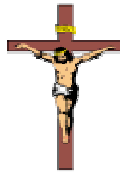

Community News

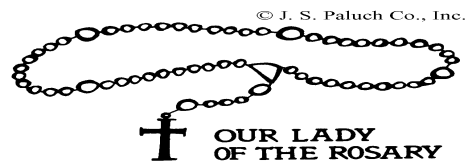

Thank you to Dawn Wanttie for the beautiful hand made beaded Rosary to adorn the statue of Mary in our church.

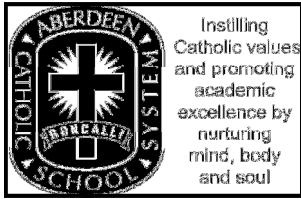
