For this reason, the ancient Irish saw this month as the beginning of the year, a time to reflect on the past, and to start over again.

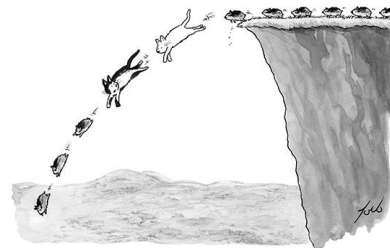


We don't begin our year in November, but there is a definite sense of endings. So, we honor those who have died during this holy month, we honor and remember them with faith.
