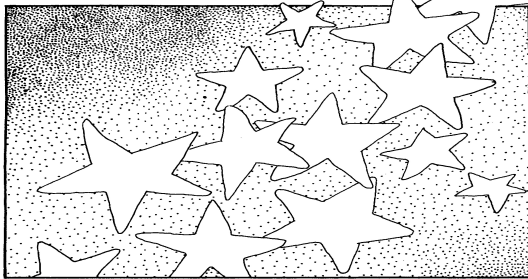

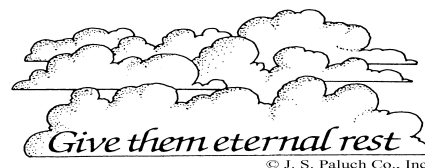

FAITH FORMATION NEWS

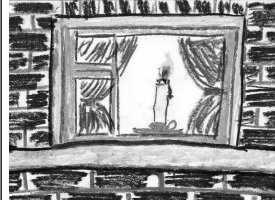
