Acts of the Apostles 2:1-11 1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13 Galatians 5:16-25



My Dear Parishioners,

"Jesus, I trust in You!" This prayer is on my lips with great frequency. In these most challenging times for sharing the convictions of our Catholic faith and bringing my people to a real lived relationship with Jesus, I am deeply aware that my limited abilities are not adequate. I need to constantly and honestly entrust my efforts to the intercession of Mary and the empowerment of the Holy Spirit. So that is why I say "Jesus, I trust in your words, especially when You say that upon your return to the Father at the Ascension you will send the Holy Spirit that will help us accomplish this magnificent task of building the Kingdom of God."

I see evidence that this prayer is being answered. For instance this Sunday at 2 pm we will observe a holy moment in our parish history as we welcome twenty children to the altar with their families as they receive Jesus in Holy Communion for the first time. They have been preparing throughout this year with special Family Masses and classes for this beautiful Sacrament. May they grow ever closer to Jesus and always feel a part of the Church.

Another sign that my prayers are being answered is the fact that St. Roch's has achieved our goal in the critically important annual appeal Partners In Charity. I am grateful for the generous response on the part of the many who made a donation or pledge. These sacrifices enable the diocese to carry out the mission of spreading the Gospel, educating the youth, assisting the needy and caring for our retired priests. The unplanned collection last week to help the people of Nepal devastated by the earthquake raised \$635 for Catholic Relief Services. These are all clear indications that we are more and more becoming an authentic Christian community. Willingness to sacrifice for the sake of the other is the essence of Christianity. "Jesus, I trust in You." Keep praying that prayer and pay attention to how it is being answered.


