Paul's Epistle Sacramentals are a wonderful aspect of our faith. These objects or images help us to seek always the graces God desires to bestow upon us. This week the church recalls the gift of the brown scapular given to St. Simon Stock by Our Lady of Mount Carmel.

Many of you may have received a brown scapular at your First Holy Communion. The simple brown cloth worn under our shirts is a sign of our devotion to Our Lady and the knowledge of our need for God's grace to aid us in perseverance in faith, hope and love. While there is a promise given that "those who die wearing this scapular shall not suffer eternal fire." it must not be seen in a superstitious or magical way, but as an outward sign of our inward disposition.

A blessed medal or crucifix around our neck is also a great way of asking God to grant us the graces needed for the challenges we face in our daily lives. The saints remind us that if we place our lives humbly before the Lord, He will bestow His grace and mercy upon us.

The 125th Legacy Celebration will be coming up on August 14th-16th in Sioux Falls and I am excited for the many great opportunities we will have to be inspired and strengthened in our Faith.
