After praver and consultation Deacon John Baker will be stepping down from public ministry in our parish. I have enjoyed his love for the church and his great insight since the day I arrived. He has brought many gifts to our parish and I will miss having him at my side during our liturgies. I have asked him to share some thoughts in our bulletin.

I was ordained to the permanent Diaconate for the Archdiocese of Dubuque in April of 1994 and served at St. Edward parish in Waterloo, IA until September of 2012. My wife Nancy and I moved back to Watertown and I continued my Diaconal duties at Immaculate Conception. A big part of our decision to move was that I had been diagnosed with early stage Alzheimer's disease.

For several years everything was okay and I became active in the parish. Several weeks ago, I began to struggle with my duties on the altar and as there is no script or book for the Deacon to follow, I started worrying about the next thing to do in the service. At first, I thought I was worrying too much about making a mistake, but Fr. Paul soon picked up on this and was concerned. As a result, Father and I will request Bishop Swain to place me on medical leave. I will continue to be active in the parish as long as I can but not as your deacon.

Our parish has been richly blessed with many young families in their support of many activities in the parish. I have baptized some of my grandchildren and witnessed the wedding vows of my children. I am praying that the younger men in our parish give serious thought and prayer to consider applying to become a Deacon. Thank you for your prayers as we continue our spiritual journey.
