Since we're now a merged bulletin this is a good time to repeat that our two (St. James and Sts. Cornelius & Cyprian) WTH pledges were created pre-merger. Thus, by rule they're separate and will be used at each campus per the original intentions of that campus. As each of these pledges mature funds are kept separated at the Lansing diocese. Funds will flow out of the accounts for each campus separately; to be used for the original purpose/s. Our merged parish office receives regular updates on each account. And you'll be glad to know that both pledges are moving right along according to plan.

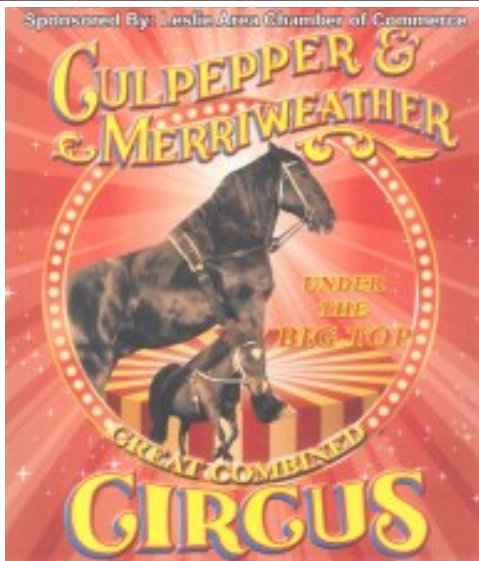

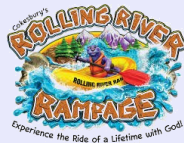

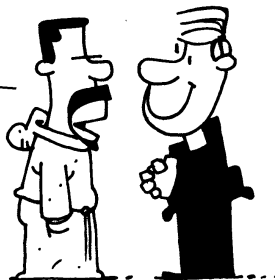
