# DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS,



As of July 1, 2018, the decree on the merger of our two parishes officially takes effect. **Our new name will be The Catholic Community of Sts. James, Cornelius & Cyprian**. We will have one Pastor, one staff, one parish council and one finance council with two

sites in Mason and Bunker Hill. Our councils will be moving our meetings from one site to the other on a regular basis. St. James will become the principal parochial church and Sts. Cornelius & Cyprian will be designated an oratory. These are merely canonical terms because we will still continue to provide Masses, sacraments and parish functions at each site as we are doing now. The Mass times will remain the same until September 30, 2018. All our Sunday contributions will go to the same pot beginning this July 1<sup>st</sup>.

During this painful and challenging time of transition, I ask that we keep one another in our prayers and let us look to the Paschal Mystery of Christ. For it is in Christ's dying and rising that we find our confidence and hope, knowing that the pains of this transition will give way to the joy of new life in a new parish community. May the peace of Christ reign in your hearts.


# ST CASIMIR ANNUAL CORN ROAST FESTIVAL
