

ST. JAMES 75TH ANNIVERSARY QUILT



When the 50th anniversary of St. James Church was commemorated in 1992, a wonderful pieced quilt was designed and handmade, and is displayed on the wall in Cave Hall.

For the 75th Anniversary—December 25, 2017—it was suggested that another quilt be designed. It was decided that this quilt

would be comprised of vintage photos which would be enlarged, printed on appropriate fabric, and sewn together surrounding our new logo in complimentary colors. The photos chosen show the original meeting place for mass—Ball Dunn Home for Funerals in Mason, now Gorsline Runciman; the original church structure; the sanctuary of both churches; the rectory; the construction of the "new" church, 1989-90; the statues of St. James, etc. One square includes the names of all 14 of our pastors from Fr. Charles Keating to Fr. Kusi.

This project took far longer than anyone anticipated. There were many decisions to be made—the choice of photos, the colors, getting the logo printed on fabric, getting the photos printed on fabric, all time-consuming efforts. St. James Church has a rich history. Narrowing that history to 16 quilt squares was a daunting task. This quilt is a gift to St. James parishioners, lovingly conceived and assembled. It celebrates several aspects of our history as well as our Catholic community and family.

We have a beautiful finished product! It was all brought together and handmade by St. James parishioner Mary Knudstrup, after she came to our rescue. The machine quilting was done by Jan Joss. The quilt was delivered to St. James recently and will be displayed in a permanent location when that is determined. 2018

It is hoped that everyone will take a few moments to appreciate the new quilt—actually a work of art. We Mary Knodstrup cannot say 'thank you' enough to Mary Knudstrup for all that she did.


