CAMINO OF ST. JAMES

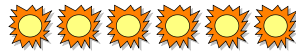

CHRISTIAN SERVICE COMMITTEE

The Christian Service Committee was formed in the late 1980s by our pastor Fr. Kenneth McDonald at St. James. He felt that the church should give to the community so directed that 6% of the amount contributed by parishioners would be distributed to various charitable organizations in the area during the year.



Each year in June—the end of our fiscal year—the committee meets to review the list of organizations that St. James (now Sts James, Cornelius & Cyprian) tithes to and make changes if necessary. At that time members can suggest a new organization for our discussion. At our meeting in June we added Cardboard Prophets and St. Luke's Soup Kitchen to our list. There are 21 agencies on our current list. The Finance Committee allocates an amount for us to work with. Currently we are working with 4% of the contributions—or \$18,500, a \$500 increase over last year's budget.

For the most part, checks are sent out once a year to each agency, one or two in each month.

CARDBOARD PROPHETS

Each weekend you may hear the announcement that "4% of our tithe of Christian Service is donated to..." We have two new originations we've added this fiscal year 2018-19 one of them is Cardboard Prophets. Cardboard Prophets is a "street-based outreach in Lansing" Mike Karl also founded Homeless Angels in Lansing. Cardboard Prophets has been helping homeless people in Lansing with places to sleep, food, gas, clothing, etc since 2017. All of the work is done by volunteers. All funds are donated. He was homeless himself and spends a week in the fall with the homeless. To give back to the community that helped him get back on his feet. They do park clean-up projects where the homeless sleep, grocery shopping sprees for families, meals prepared and served outside for the hungry, distribution of non-perishable food items, diapers and baby supplies, finding places to stay and even help finding work. Another project supported by Cardboard Prophets is Tiny Pantry which is similar to the Tiny Libraries that people may have seen on streets and roads. Donated food is available to take by the needy. Cardboard Prophets has a Facebook page and a website, as does Homeless Angels, which St. James also donates to.

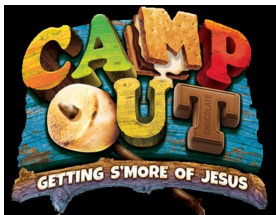
