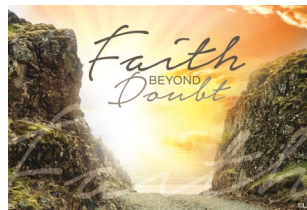


MADE FOR HAPPINESS ASSEMBLY

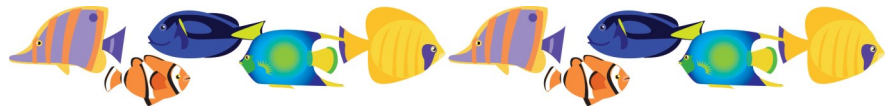

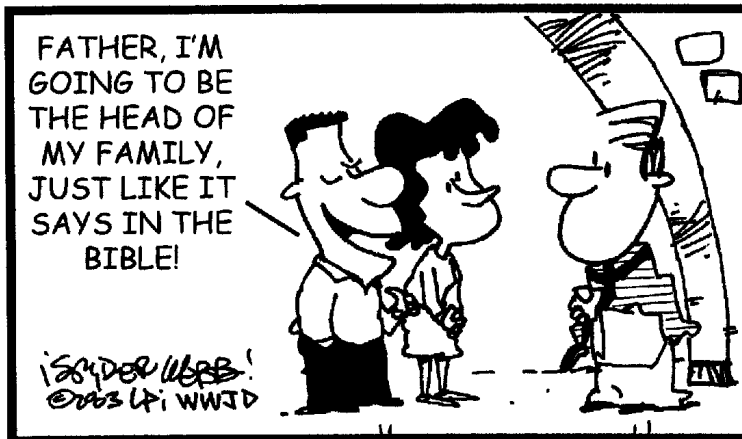
