

ST. JAMES 75THANNIVERSARY—DECEMBER 25, 2017

Our Tabernacle-present and past:

The finest white linen fabric of Dec Moire' was used for the upper adornment covering for our Tabernacle leaving the cross exposed. White and silver edged roses were hand stitched through out and have rhinestone/diamond embellishments in their centers signifying 75 years of St. James Church. Along the edges of the covering is a shiny sparkly double ribbon woven in a plaiting design that was also done 2,000 years ago signifying biblical time. White Acuna Milk fabric was made to curtain the doors of the tabernacle. It was also used and secured to the panels of the pedestal that supports the Tabernacle. The first covering was used over the tabernacle and framework formed the tabernacle and made it one Exodus

26:6 to represent the ten curtains bringing together making one. The Second and final Adornment covering "The red velvet and gold accessories" represents the actual season, Christmas time and a birthday garment for our Lord Jesus Christ on December 25th,1942, when St. James Mission originally opened its doors and Altar to the people for the first Mass. My profound thank you to my Lord for having chosen the fabrics and style that I was to use and last but never least, for using ME.
