CHRIST IS RISEN!!!

"Christ is alive." This is the great truth which fills our faith with meaning. Jesus, who died on the cross, has risen. He has triumphed over death; he has overcome sorrow, anguish and the power of darkness. "Do not be terrified" was how the angels greeted the women who came to the tomb. "Do not be terrified. You are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He has risen; he is not here." "This is the day which the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it."

Easter is a time of joy — a joy not confined to this period of the liturgical year, but to be found really and fully in the Christian's heart. For Christ is alive. He is not someone who has gone, someone who existed for a time and then passed on, leaving us a wonderful example and a great memory.

No, Christ is alive. Jesus is the Emmanuel: God with us. His resurrection shows us that God does not abandon his own. He promised he would not: "Can a woman forget her baby that is still unweaned, pity no longer the son she bore in her womb? Even these may forget, yet I will not forget you." And he has kept his promise. His delight is still to be with the sons of men.

Christ is alive in his Church. "I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Counsellor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you." That was what God planned: Jesus, dying on the cross, gave us the Spirit of truth and life. Christ stays in his Church, its sacraments, its liturgy, its preaching — in all that it does.

In a special way Christ stays with us in the daily offering of the holy Eucharist. That is why the Mass is the center and source of christian life. In each and every Mass the complete Christ, head and body, is present. Per Ipsum et cum Ipso et in Ipso. For Christ is the way; he is the mediator; in him we find everything. Outside of him our life is empty. In Jesus Christ, and taught by him, "we dare to say: Our Father." We dare to call the Lord of heaven and earth our Father. The presence of the living Christ in the host is the guarantee, the source and the culmination of his presence in the world.

CRISTO HA RESUCITADO!

Cristo vive. Esta es la gran verdad que llena de contenido nuestra fe. Jesús, que murió en la cruz, ha resucitado, ha triunfado de la muerte, del poder de las tinieblas, del dolor y de la angustia. *No temáis*, con esta invocación saludó un ángel a las mujeres que iban al sepulcro; *no temáis*. Vosotras venís a buscar a Jesús Nazareno, que fue crucificado: ya resucitó, no está aquí (Mc 16,6). *Haec est dies quam fecit Dominus, exultemus et laetemur in ea*; éste es el día en que actuó el Señor: sea nuestra alegría y nuestro gozo (Sal 117,24).

El tiempo pascual es tiempo de alegría, de una alegría que no se limita a esa época del año litúrgico, sino que se asienta en todo momento en el corazón del cristiano. Porque Cristo vive: Cristo no es una figura que pasó, que existió en un tiempo y que se fue, dejándonos un recuerdo y un ejemplo maravillosos.

No: Cristo vive. Jesús es el Emmanuel: Dios con nosotros. Su Resurrección nos revela que Dios no abandona a los suyos. *¿Puede la mujer olvidarse del fruto de su vientre, no compadecerse del hijo de sus entrañas? Pues aunque ella se olvidare, yo no me olvidaré de ti* (Is 49,14-15), había prometido. Y ha cumplido su promesa. Dios sigue teniendo sus delicias entre los hijos de los hombres (Cfr. Prov 8,31).

Cristo vive en su Iglesia. *"Os digo la verdad: os conviene que yo me vaya; porque si yo no me voy, el Consolador no vendrá a vosotros, pero si me voy, os lo enviaré"* (Jn 16,7). Esos eran los designios de Dios: Jesús, muriendo en la Cruz, nos daba el Espíritu de Verdad y de Vida. Cristo permanece en su Iglesia: en sus sacramentos, en su liturgia, en su predicación, en toda su actividad.

De modo especial Cristo sigue presente entre nosotros, en esa entrega diaria de la Sagrada Eucaristía. Por eso la Misa es centro y raíz de la vida cristiana. En toda Misa está siempre el Cristo Total, Cabeza y Cuerpo. *Per Ipsum, et cum Ipso et in Ipso*. Porque Cristo es el Camino, el Mediador: en El, lo encontramos todo; fuera de El, nuestra vida queda vacía. En Jesucristo, e instruidos por El, nos atrevemos a decir *—audemus dicere— Pater noster*, Padre nuestro. Nos atrevemos a llamar Padre al Señor de los cielos y de la tierra. **(de "Es Cristo que pasa", San José María Escrivá de Balaguer)**
