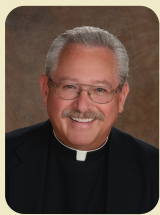

### *From the Pastor*

#### Reflection on the 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter, Cycle B

##### First Reading: Acts 9:26-31

The setting of the First Reading is after Paul has been converted and has been preaching for the Lord. The Jewish people have decided to kill him and have been watching for their chance. Many of the disciples were still afraid of him. Barnabas helps him, but Paul shows the tremendous courage which resulted from his encounter with the risen Lord. As he builds relationships and continues to preach he become more secure but is also continuously threatened because of his work for the Lord.

##### Second Reading: 1 John 3:18-24

After a section on avoiding sin, the First Letter of John turns to a discussion of the Law of Love. The meat of his message is "Those who keep his commandments remain in him, and he in them..." It is simple, if we act out the Law of Love, we remain connected to the Lord. The Gospel will tell us that if we remain connected to the Lord we will be given the nourishment we need to act out the Law of Love. They go hand-in-hand.

##### Gospel: John 15:1-8

The Gospels often talk about faith in the Lord, knowing the Lord and other concepts that imply relationship with the Lord. The setting for today's selection is a relatively long discourse after the Last Supper. Jesus is speaking to his inner circle and describes relationship with the Lord using the imagery of the relationship between vines, their branches and the vine grower.

The relationship described in today's selection is a relationship with a purpose, fruitfulness. Fruitfulness is a broad term. There are many ways of being fruitful but fruitfulness, as used in Scripture, is, by its very nature, life-giving. This concept of being fruitful is different from being productive or successful in that it is always life-giving. Being productive usually implies accomplishing something; it is normally thing oriented. Being successful usually implies accomplishing a purpose which could be either good or bad.

God never asks us to be productive or successful, but He always wants us to be fruitful. Being fruitful is an application of the Law of Love. We probably all know people who are fruitful in relationship. Knowing them make us feel like we matter. Relationship with them makes us want to be better people, maybe to be worthy of their notice. Relationship with them affirms our existence, it makes us feel alive, it is life-giving. Relationship with them is fruitful and loving.

This fruitfulness should also exist in the momentary contacts between us and store clerks, food service workers, repair people, receptionists, or anybody else with whom we come into contact. But, it's not that easy. Our stress, our self-concern, our moods, our preoccupations, our prejudices, etc. can all get in the way of fruitful interactions with others. That's why we need to stay connected to the Lord.

The imagery from today's selection suggests that, if we are not fruitful, we will be removed from the vine and thrown away. I think it is our lack of fruitfulness that removes us from the vine, all by itself. The inverse is also true, our fruitfulness brings us closer to the Lord. Remember that, if we are fruitful, the Father prunes us to increase our fruitfulness. We might experience that pruning as the struggle and the pain of growing into the better person God wants us to be.

This week might be a good time to reflect on how we stay more connected with the Lord. Maybe it is developing a more regular prayer life centered on the Mass and the Eucharist. Maybe it includes the practice of regular Reconciliation to help us rid ourselves of the things which get in the way of right-relationship. Maybe it includes regular Scriptural or other spiritual reading to help us stay focused on growth as a human being. Maybe it includes backing our ego-selves out of interactions with others to make a place for the Lord.

## PARISH FINANCES

In order to fulfill our budget, we need to collect an average of \$12,722 in the collection basket each week. Some weeks may be higher and some lower but we need to maintain that average. Additionally, we have budgeted for an average of \$12,802 to be contributed monthly through our Online Giving contribution program.

The total amount budgeted through these sources is \$660,095 this year. Our budget includes another \$106,384 expected income from other sources; (Annual Catholic Appeal rebates, Christmas & Easter collections, Sacramental Donations, Interest, One-time gifts & bequests, etc.).

### Helping Bags for the Homeless

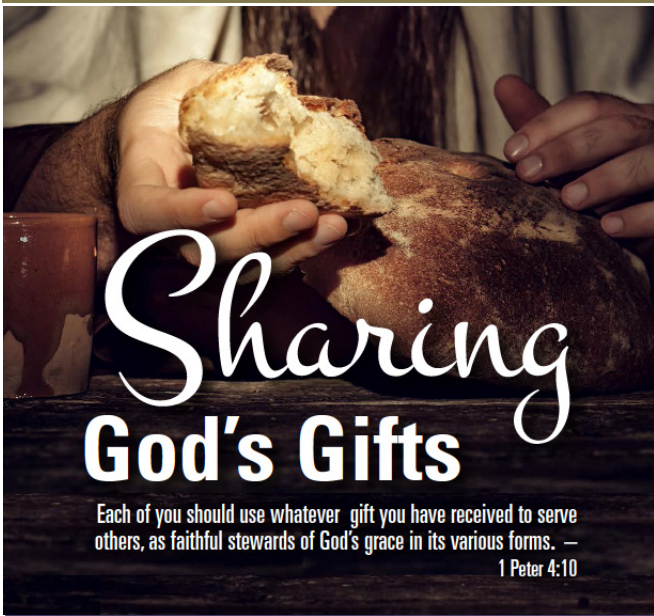
