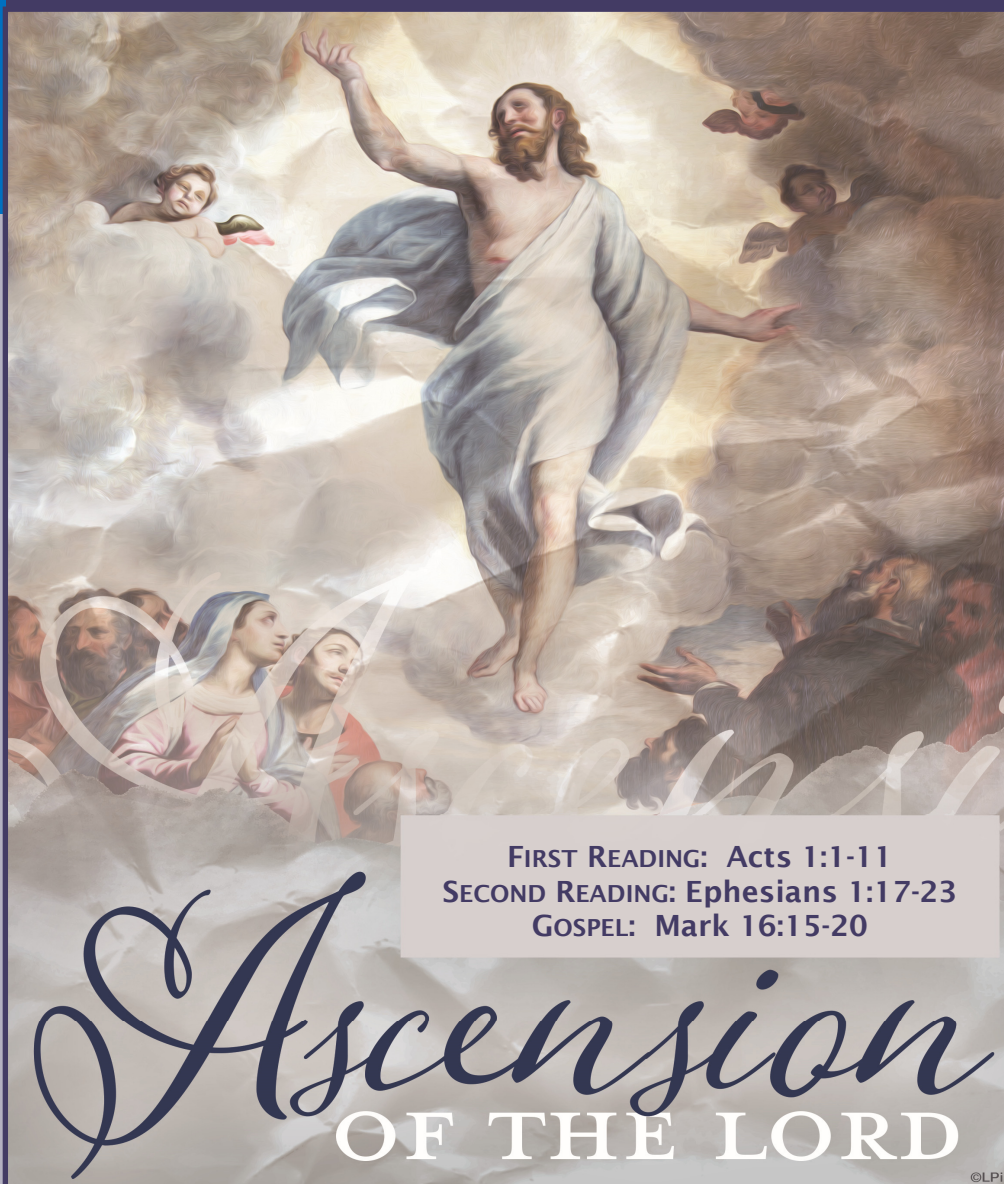

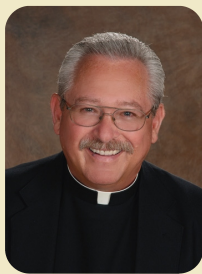

### *From the Pastor*

The Gospel selection for today is part of what is called the Longer Ending (16: 9-20) to the Gospel of Mark. It includes post-resurrection appearances, the commissioning of the eleven and the Ascension itself. Most scripture scholars believe this ending is not original to Mark. It is missing from the major early manuscripts although it existed by the middle of the second century. Nevertheless, it is canonical and contains important teaching.

The concept of belief is a major element of the Longer Ending. When Mary Magdalene told Jesus' companions that she had seen Him alive, they did not believe. When the two disciples who were walking along on their way to the country told them they had seen Him, they didn't believe them either. When Jesus then appeared to the eleven, while they were at table, he rebuked them for their unbelief. After He commissioned them to proclaim the Gospel to every creature, he said that those who believe will be saved and those who do not believe will be condemned.

The Gospel describes signs that will accompany true belief, driving out demons, speaking new languages, protection from serpents and poison; and, healing the sick. We know, from Scripture itself, that such signs did exist in the early Church. There are several references to healings and speaking in tongues. And, there are Christian traditions to this day who emphasize the existence of such signs. There are Charismatic groups who emphasize praying in tongues. Healing services in churches who hold them are often well attended. There are Churches within what we call the Pentecostal Holiness tradition who purposely handle snakes or drink poison as a test or, maybe, a proof, of their faith. Most of us, though, would probably say we don't have such explicit signs in our lives.

When I think about these signs as they relate to our day-and-time, I'm always reminded of Lindsey Buckingham's, of Fleetwood Mac, song "My Little Demon". I agree with Lindsey when he says "all of us have inner demons that we struggle with". I'm also reminded of Joe Walsh, whose demons got the best of him. He named his demon "vodka" and after eighteen years of sobriety wrote the song "One Day at a Time". He sings of getting on his knees and says "I got help from something greater than me." I see his sobriety as a strong sign of his faith in his "something greater than me" that I take to be the Lord.

Many of us know someone who has been physically healed but more often, I think, we know people who have been emotionally healed. This type of healing takes a tremendous amount of work and a tremendous amount of trust on the part of the one who is suffering. Oftentimes this type of healing comes when someone preaches the Gospel to them by simply loving them. It is the Gospel spoken without words that gives them faith in life itself, faith in the Creator of life. Their healing is a sign of the struggle into which they entered, the work they did, and the faith that got them through.

We are all called to preach the Gospel without fear of that which tries to stop us, to learn to speak to people rather than at them, to help people face their demons and to bring them the healing power of God's love.

## PARISH FINANCES

In order to fulfill our budget, we need to collect an average of \$12,722 in the collection basket each week. Some weeks may be higher and some lower but we need to maintain that average. Additionally, we have budgeted for an average of \$12,802 to be contributed monthly through our Online Giving contribution program.

The total amount budgeted through these sources is \$660,095 this year. Our budget includes another \$106,384 expected income from other sources; (Annual Catholic Appeal rebates, Christmas & Easter collections, Sacramental Donations, Interest, One-time gifts & bequests, etc.).

**Next Weekend is Missionary Cooperation Sunday. Our Missionary Speaker will be Ann O'Donnell from Hands Together: A Catholic Mission Outreach Working in Haiti**

Hands Together was founded in 1986 by Fr. Tom Hagan after he led a group of Lafayette College students to Haiti and was compelled to respond to the needs of the poor there. He left his post as Catholic Chaplain of Princeton University and moved to Port-au-Prince in 1997. Since then, Hands Together has emerged as a key educational and development organization working in Haiti's largest and poorest slum, Cite Soleil. We have built free schools where there were none and provided every student with a daily hot meal.



We have 7 campuses, including a high school, as well as a free clinic and an elderly outreach and housing program. We are one of Cite Soleil's largest employers, giving decent, service-oriented jobs to hundreds of residents.

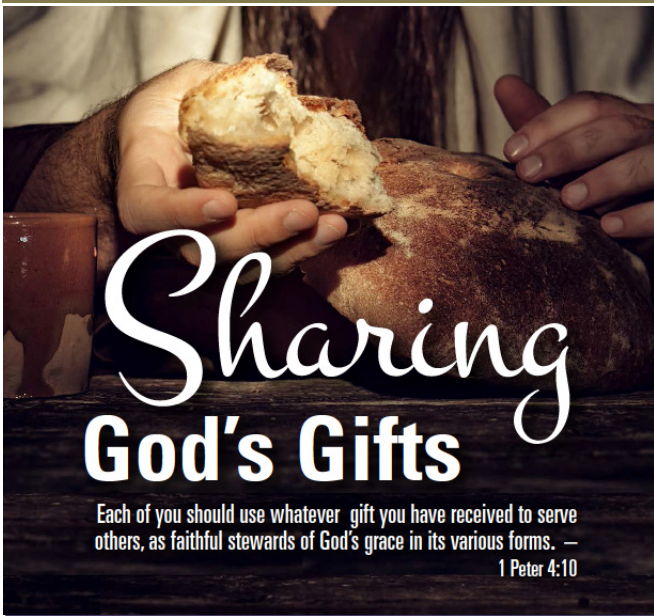
Our programs outside of Port-au-Prince promote human development among the rural poor through water well digging, agricultural programs and production, and assisting the poorest schools, clinics, and parishes in the northern diocese of Gonaives and in Cap Haitien.

Hands Together provides hope to the poor living in Haiti. Our work is founded upon the Catholic teaching that recognizes the dignity of every human life and a fundamental responsibility to the poor and vulnerable.

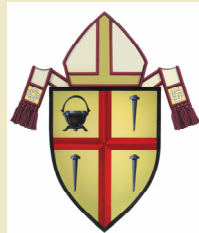

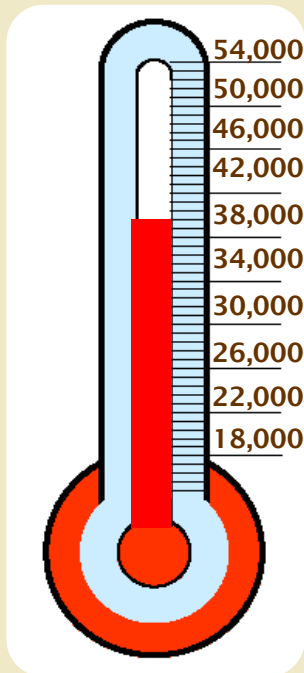

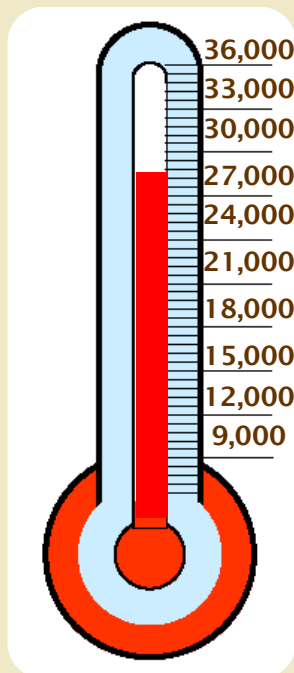
