## 15<sup>th</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

FIRST READING: AMOS 7:15

SECOND READING: EPHESIANS 1:3-14

GOSPEL: MARK 6:7-13

**Reflection:** Reflect upon and/or share about a time when you particularly felt that your life had purpose. How might your experience have been similar to the experience of the early Church being given purpose by Jesus as his delegates? What can you do to help live your life more purposefully as one who has been sent by Jesus to fulfill the mission he gave the Church (preach repentance, drive out demons, cure the sick).

**Alternative:** Think about/share about a time when you were given a job or a mission to accomplish. What was the mission? What types of difficulties or distractions did you have to deal with? What could you have done to focus better on what you were given to accomplish? What can you do to focus your life more on the mission which Jesus has given the Church?

## *From the Pastor*

Dear Parishioners,

Thank you to everyone who made my 12<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration such a wonderful experience. I was overwhelmed when I saw the list of everyone who made it happen. Thanks to you who donated money for the event. Thanks to you who prepared food for us to share; I couldn't taste every separate thing but boy was I tempted. Thanks to you who took the time to come and share the celebration with me. I was really touched. And, thanks to all of you who wanted to come but couldn't for a variety of reasons. I understand, and I appreciate your words of support. Thanks to all of you who gave me cards and gifts of one sort or another. Your generosity humbles me. I thank God for all of you.

I particularly thank those of you who sometimes disagree with my interpretation of the Gospel. I know that you are sometimes upset with me and I appreciate the fact that you support me anyway. That's very mature. I'm not the most emotionally mature person in the world and I am really hurt by knowing that some people dislike my preaching of the Gospel. The support I felt on Saturday made me reflect and made me realize that I can't let the ire of some stop me from my ministry. I need to do my best at preaching God's word as it relates to our day and time and pray that I am being faithful to He who calls us together.

My twelve years at St. Luke have gone pretty fast for me. Some people ask me if I think the Bishop will move me and I always tell them that he can't. In our diocese we don't have term limits, so Canon Law protect pastors; we have to agree to be moved or the Bishop can't move us. I would only move if the Bishop convinces me that there is a particular need for me to serve at some other parish. By the way, young priests will normally move if the Bishop asks them because they are aware that they have many years wherein they have to get along with their boss. Otherwise, the Bishop can only move a pastor in the case of a scandal of some sort.

So, I plan to be here for five more years when I will be retiring at age 75. I love everything about my ministry except for office work, by the way. I love presiding at Mass, I love Confessions, I love visiting the sick and homebound; and, I love talking to people about their spiritual life and their struggles in this life. I just don't like the financial and administrative side of pastoring.

I believe the ministry of pastoring should be separate from the job of administrating. I've made that known to the body of priests on a couple of occasions. They just laugh, not because they disagree with me but because they can't conceive how that would happen. It would require the parishes to spend a considerable amount for another salary and most parishes are struggling financially these days. Still, I think it is a matter of justice that we try.

Another thing people ask me is who will replace me and will I have any say so in who will be my replacement. I don't know. I will make it known that I think this parish deserves a preacher who can help people connect the Gospel to their day-to-day lives. And, of course, it should be someone who loves God's people, especially families and their children. We have done a lot of work, here at St. Luke, to involve the children in the life of the parish and make Church something they will want in their adult lives. I would like to see that effort carried on.

On the other hand, I have to trust the work of the Holy Spirit and believe that the parish will get exactly what it needs.

Thank you all for making my twelfth anniversary so special.

## PARISH FINANCES

In order to fulfill our budget, we need to collect an average of \$12,722 in the collection basket each week. Some weeks may be higher and some lower, but we need to maintain that average. Additionally, we have budgeted for an average of \$12,802 to be contributed monthly through our Online Giving contribution program.

The total amount budgeted through these sources is \$660,095 this year.

Our budget includes another \$106,384 expected income from other sources; (Annual Catholic Appeal rebates, Christmas & Easter collections, Sacramental donations, interest, one-time gifts and bequests, etc.).

## GOSPEL MEDITATION ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

July 15, 2018

15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

*"He summoned the Twelve and began to send them out two by two."*

This Sunday we read the first sending of the Apostles to preach, teach, and heal. For many of us, it can be easy to think we "just don't have enough" to be disciples and evangelists ourselves. We don't have enough education and training. We don't have enough experience talking to people about Jesus. We don't pray enough. We don't have enough faith.

If you look at the Apostles in today's Gospel reading, they didn't have much either. "No food, no sack, no money in their belts." They didn't plan out their itinerary or book their lodging in advance. From what we know of the Apostles, they were not the religiously trained and educated ones. They were fisherman, tax collectors, and political activists. But what does being a fisherman require? Someone like Peter needed a strong work ethic to rise at strange hours. He needed patient calm to wait for the catch. Once ashore, he needed a savvy mind to fetch a good price for his labors.

As Peter became a fisher of men, he would need diligence to persevere through the hard journeys, long days, and persecution that awaited him. He would need patient calm with those who disagreed with him. As the leader of the Apostles, he would need a savvy mind to navigate challenges facing the early Church. From one perspective, Peter has nothing to offer the mission of Jesus. Thinking more creatively, one can see that -- joined with faith and love -- perhaps Peter had everything he needed.

Jesus sends you as well. As you take stock of your own talents, consider how they might be offered as a gift to others. Maybe you already have more than enough.

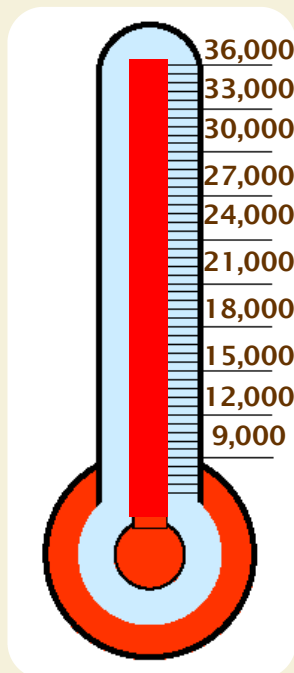
