### From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

I've received many letters and emails, and have spoken to many people, about the revelations from the Pennsylvania Grand Jury Report. In that, I'm told that our children are confused and that parents don't quite know what to say to them.

I take a cue from an article I found on NPR. It is entitled "How To Talk To Young People About The Kavanaugh Story." The author points out, as advice from experts, that it is a teachable moment and that parents are the ones having responsibility to teach their children. But, when are children ready to talk about what they are hearing from the news, from adult conversations or from conversations with other children. My guess is that they need to talk about it with their parents at least by the time they first start hearing about it from other sources.

What do you tell them? At some point, they are going to learn that many people do bad things, even people they trust. I think they need to learn about that before they are hurt by any of those people. They need to learn, at some level, that even priests, other Church ministers, teachers, coaches, almost anyone working with children, and even relatives or other children can do things that are harmful to them. They also need to know that their parents will keep them safe. I think it might be comforting to them to know that their parents are pressuring the Church, schools and sports programs to make sure they are safe places for their children.

They need to know what to do if they are ever in that situation. We use the "No Go Tell" rule to teach children in our Faith Formation Classes what they should do. "No Go Tell" is taught in schools, recreations centers and other facilities to help children protect themselves from abuse, bullying, prejudice, etc. Basically, it states that if anyone touches you or does something which makes you feel scared, weird or uncomfortable tell them "no", yelling it if you have to. It then says to "Go"; get away from them as soon as it is safe. Finally, tell an adult whom you trust about what happened. You can find discussion of the "No Go Tell" rule on-line. One of the things I was impressed with in the NPR article, was the parent who annually checked with her children to make sure they knew other adults they could go to if they needed to discuss something they didn't want to discuss with her, their mother. I think that shows real humility and love. She recognizes that our children, no matter what our relationship with them, may at times not want to discuss something with us, for whatever reason. In times past, it may have been aunts or uncles who were close to their age or older cousins. Now with smaller families and families living further apart, we should make sure they have someone.

It seems to me that with the media and internet, children are being made aware of some of the difficult realities of life sooner than we ever were. When I was young, I think we were allowed to enjoy youthful naivete much longer. Today, everything is right out there. To try to protect our children from knowing about it might be a disservice. Each parent must weigh that.

I highly recommend that parents read the NPR article which is included in the bulletin this weekend.

## PARISH FINANCES

In order to fulfill our budget, we need to receive an average of \$12,722 in the collection basket each week. Some weeks may be higher and some lower, but we need to maintain that average. Additionally, we have budgeted for an average of \$12,802 to be contributed monthly through our Online Giving contribution program.

The total amount budgeted through these sources is \$660,095 this year.

Our budget includes another \$106,384 expected income from other sources; (Annual Catholic Appeal rebates, Christmas & Easter collections, Sacramental donations, interest, one-time gifts and bequests, etc.).

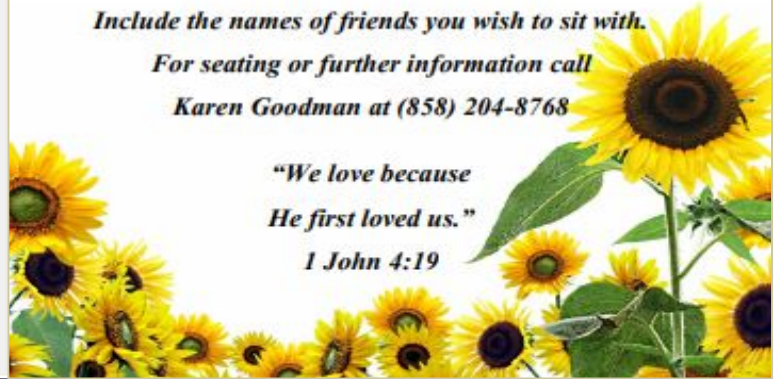

### **October "A Time to Listen" with Bishop McElroy**

Bishop McElroy will be hosting a series of "Listening Sessions" in October as a result of the crisis we face as a church due to the sexual abuse of minors and other vulnerable adults by clergy, and the failure of bishops to adequately protect those entrusted to their care. 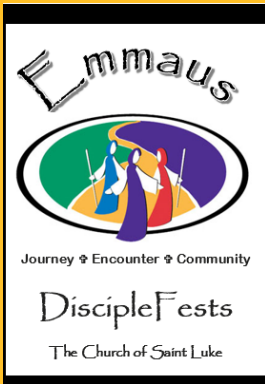
