From the Pastor



Dear parishioners,

I'm watching a movie that I like. My brother turned me on to it. That is actually kind of funny because he once told me that every time an immigrant comes to this country, his quality of life goes down. He has since met many immigrants and discovered, for the most part, that they are good people too. He has immigrant friends that he now trusts and depends on.

The movie, by the way, is *McFarland USA*. It is a true story about a high school coach who has lost several jobs and has to take a job in a small town primarily inhabited by immigrants from Mexico. They have a losing football team and he doesn't get along with the head coach anyway so he loses that part of his job.

He notices that most of the kids in this town can run. They run all the time anyway from the fields where they work early in the morning to school and back to work or home after school. He starts a cross country track team which he has to force students to join. They do and they become winners, which is what the story is all about but it's not easy.

The part that really touched my heart this time was when the coach was trying to understand the families of his runners. One of the families pulled their three sons from the team so they could work in the fields and help support the family. The coach, trying to understand what his runners experience as life, got up early and boarded the truck to go to work with them. By the way, this is a true story.

Yeah, you guessed it... It was the hardest work he ever did and he didn't do so well at it. But, he did gain the respect of the community because he put in the effort to understand them in an experiential way. It reminds me of the aphorism, before you judge someone, walk a mile in their shoes. I know people disagree with me in this but, I think, there is too little understanding of the other in our world today. Somehow the lack of understanding is connected to fear of the other and the hatred that usually follows.

I was really impressed by the coach in this story. He struggled. He wanted to leave *McFarland* but he eventually chose to stay. He chose relationship over his concepts of safety and he is still there today. I highly recommend this movie. But, don't miss it's message about immigrants.

PARISH FINANCES

In order to fulfill our budget, we need to receive an average of \$12,722 in the collection basket each week. Some weeks may be higher and some lower, but we need to maintain that average. Additionally, we have budgeted for an average of \$12,802 to be contributed monthly through our Online Giving contribution program.

The total amount budgeted through these sources is \$660,095 this year.

Our budget includes another \$106,384 expected income from other sources; (Annual Catholic Appeal rebates, Christmas & Easter collections, Sacramental donations, interest, one-time gifts and bequests, etc.).

East County **Christmas 4 Kids** Children's Book Drive




We need your gently used or new children's books for kids this Christmas!

One of our parish Christmas traditions is our community of disciples helping to bring comfort and joy to our brothers and sisters in need. Our annual *Giving Tree* effort primarily serves families in local communities as well as families across the border in Tecate and Tijuana.

Administering the **Giving Tree project** over the past twenty–seven years has proven to be fruitful as well. To more effectively meet the challenges of volunteer resources and the time demands placed on our parish families, the 2016 plan was modified and was well received and appreciated by everyone.

With that in mind, we have decided to use the same strategy again this Christmas.

We will support designated schools and organizations in need of our help. This year, we will partner with a select number of Cajon Valley schools, Crisis House, EJE Academies, El Nido (a project of the Interfaith Shelter Network), and Friends of the Poor.
