## **Bulletin Bites**

Mark 16:15-20

The site and circumstances of the Ascension are presented differently in the Gospels. St Matthew says it was in Galilee [Matthew 28:16-20]; St Mark has it in Jerusalem [Mark 16:9-20]; St Luke places it in Bethany [Luke 24:50-52]; St. John does not mention it; and in Acts St. Luke has it “on the mount called Olivet” [Acts 2:11-12]. There is a site on the top Mount of Olives, above the Garden of Gethsemane, that is revered by Christians as the site where Jesus last touched the earth. Do the different accounts of the Ascension mean it did not occur? **NO!** Jesus handed on his mission here on earth to the apostles and left them to return to the Father. He told them of the great things they would do in his name if they had faith in Him. It is likely He told them more than once and in different places. The important thing is that they did believe Him. They did great thing because of their faith in Jesus. And we are challenged to do great things because of our faith in Jesus who ascended to His Father. That is our mission.
