The Blind Taste Test...In marketing, a blind taste test is often used as a tool for companies to compare their brand to another brand. For example, the "the Pepsi Challenge" is a famous taste test that has been run by Pepsi since the mid 70's as a method to show their superiority to Coca-Cola. Taste tests are also a tool sometimes used by companies to develop their brand or new product. There are two types of blind taste tests. The single blind test is where the experimenters know the information about the participants but the participants do not know anything about the experimenters or the product that they are testing. Then there's the double blind taste test, the experimenters know nothing about the participants. The aforementioned Pepsi Challenge is an example of a single blind test.

Taste tests are also commonly employed by the public television on a cooking show aired on Create TV, the show America's Test Kitchen, and its spin-off series Cook's Country. If you've watched it, it's typically administered by Jack Bishop. When giving a blind taste test, the tasters are blind to the product they are trying. This means that the food/drink is provided to the taster in a way that does not jeopardize their opinion or allow them to identify the product. They may be told that it is a certain type of food, but brand names are withheld and the items are provided in an identical manner. The food or drink is presented in such a way that it should not alter the taster's opinion based on the appearance of the sample. The taster should differentiate the samples only by taste. But...we should never be blind to what we see or taste in our Lord.

Psalm 34, a traditional Eucharistic Psalm, reminds us that we gather to "taste and see the goodness of the Lord." We, too, are encouraged to taste and see God's goodness.
