Holy Baptism

Dear Padre'...Question: Why does the Church regulate postures and gestures during the Mass? What are the proper postures and gestures for the faithful during Mass?

The posture and gesture are there to preserve the sacred nature of the liturgy and to benefit the faithful. The norms for posture and gesture are laid out in both the *Sacramentary* (big red book, Roman Missal) and the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal* (GIRM), you can also find them in your Missalettes. The postures and gestures of both the celebrant and the faithful contribute to the "beauty and noble simplicity" of the liturgy. They point to "the true and full meaning of the different parts of the celebration," and foster the participation of all.

What is done in postures and gestures is often look at as an up and down movement. We stand generally when we are in prayer. We sit generally when we are listening. We kneel when Christ is made present in respect of him in the Eucharist. Sometimes there are other gestures and they will involve hand motions. We make the sign of cross at the beginning and at the end of Mass. We sign ourselves on our head, mouth, and heart at the proclamation of the gospel... "May the word of God be in my mind, on my lips, and in my heart".

During the **Profession of Faith**, our Creed, all are to make a profound bow (a bow of the body) at the words, "By the power of the Holy Spirit he was born of the Virgin Mary and became man." On the Solemnities of the Annunciation (March 25th) and of the Nativity of the Lord (December 25th), all genuflect if possible at this time.

No particular gesture is prescribed for the **Lord's Prayer** for the people. The Presider, as the one presiding over the liturgy extends his hands as he gathers those prayers of others, the faithful and offers them up to our heavenly Father. That is the duty of a priest. Whenever the priest is praying on behalf of the faithful he has his hands extended, the "Oran" position.

At the **Rite of Peace** all are to make an appropriate sign of peace, according to local custom. The sign should express peace, communion, and charity. It is, however, appropriate that each person offer the sign of peace only to those who are nearest and in a sober manner. When **receiving Holy Communion**, the communicant bows his or her head before the Sacrament as a gesture of reverence and receives the Body of the Lord from the minister. When Holy Communion is received under both kinds, the sign of reverence is also made before receiving the Precious Blood. The faithful contribute to the beauty of the liturgy. And by their joyful participation, the faithful more readily direct their minds and hearts toward the sacred mystery of the Mass. **Padre' Jerry**
