**Question:** Why does God give us free will? Even though God loves us. He doesn't want to shove us. Ha! We have to make our own decisions: we have to run our own race.

Once there was a little girl who was running as fast as she could, trying not to be late for religion class (man, that seems to happen all the time, doesn't it?). Well, as she ran, she

prayed. Dear Lord. please don't let me be late! While she was running and praying, she tripped on the curb and fell, getting her clothes dirty and torn. She got up, brushed herself off, and started running again. As she ran she once again began to pray, Dear Lord, please don't let me be late... but please don't shove me either!

As Catholic Christians and as children of God, we are given a radical freedom and free will...to listen and obey or to turn and run. God has not done this in order to mock us and watch us fail. Rather, he allows us the freedom to choose to love him and be loved by him, leaving open the possibility that we might also go our way. The Spirit of God's providence is always moving us in the right direction of life and love and faith. God continues to encourage and direct us to deeper spirituality...a deeper relationship with him. God will never force us or manipulate us, or even shove us. God will always allow us to make our decisions not in fear, but in freedom. You may think at times, some freedom, but it is. We choose God or reject God. We choose to follow or not. Yes, we even choose to fall or not. God may not keep us **from falling** when we choose to run away from him, but he will not abandon us if we do. His mercy is everlasting. He forgives, brushes the *dirt* off us, picks us up, and puts us back on the path but we have to run the race...we have to make the choices.
