Psalm 23

How often do we truly appreciate the Psalms? Psalm 23 from today's readings is one of the most well known and famous psalms. Its verse uses two images, shepherd and host, to communicate how graciously God cares for, feeds, nurtures and protects. It is easy to see the appropriateness of the verse we all sing together. God

> never abandons the people. In Jeremiah when the appointed leaders failed to care, God intervenes and promises to call forth new shepherds (1st reading). Then in the gospel when the disciples are lost and exhausted and the crowds become leaderless, Jesus responds to both with tender attention. We might often ask

as we sing this psalm whether we are the crowd in need of care and direction or, like the disciples, in need of rest. I think if we look deeply enough we will probably see we need both and that to every need Jesus pays heed. May we seek him with a sincere heart and may we rest in him from both the labors of discipleship and the pain of every need.

We are all shepherded by the One who calls. I hope you have a fun filled festival today working side-by-side with each other for the good of others.
