The message of Divine Mercy is as easy as A,B,C: A – Ask for God's mercy; B – Be merciful to others; C – Completely trust in. Mercy is Forgiveness... Forgive all who have offended you, if not for them, do it for yourself. Forgiveness is an act of the will, and the will can function regardless of the temperature of the heart. Have you ever seen the bumper sticker ... Christians aren't perfect, they're forgiven? The door has been opened for us by Christ himself for mercy and forgiveness, whether our sin is great or small. Often we have the tendency to feel like what we do is unforgivable. But it's not... we may be held accountable, but we should know that forgiveness is there. In the Lord's Prayer we ask God to forgive us as we forgive others. After we have knelt at Jesus' feet, like the unnamed women in Luke's Gospel, asking for pardon, then we must be ready to extend pardon to those who have wronged us. What a difference it is to know we are sinners, then turn to God and name our sin, and receive that mercy. I think we all know one can't hide... yes, God knows us and our sin... because of that he's ready to forgive and heal us. But do we seek him out in reconciliation? When you hold resentment toward another, you are bound to that person or condition by an emotional link that is stronger than steel. Forgiveness is the only way to dissolve that link and get free. Married couples can tell us... There is no love without forgiveness, and there is no forgiveness without love. To forgive is to set one free and in doing so we discover that the one set free is ourselves. - Father Jerry
