Stained Glass Window Project - As most of you have heard by now, there is some serious work that needs done to repair the decaying and rotting wood in the beautiful stained glass windows of our church. In order to complete restoration of the windows, our current church repair fund will be essentially depleted which will not allow for further repairs and upkeep needed. The Diocese of Toledo will conduct four inquiry sessions for men who are interested in learning about the deacon formation program. A potential candidate must attend one of the following meetings:

Thursday, October 20th at the Pastoral Center in Toledo

The meetings will begin at 7:00 p.m. A fifth meeting will be held on Tuesday, November 15th at Fostoria, St. Wendelin for the potential candidates and their spouses. The theology of the diaconate and the process of formation will be presented. Men who are accepted to following the inquiry phase would then go through a year of Aspirancy and three years of Candidacy leading to ordination in September, 2021.
