Dear Padre

Question: How does one evaluate ones moral acts?

Morality considers the rightness and wrongness of human actions. We can only morally evaluate those human actions performed freely and knowingly. There are three basic sources or elements that determine the morality of human acts.

- 1. The object of the act (what the act is objectively).
- 2. The intention or purpose of the act (why the act is chosen subjectively).
- 3. The circumstances surrounding the act.

For an act to be morally good, all three of these elements must be good. If anyone is defective, then the act is morally bad. For example, praying, which is objectively good, becomes bad if it is done with bad intention of gaining human praise. Evil intentions corrupt otherwise good actions. God created man and woman for the good of procreation in marriage life...outside of it would be against God's intention. Good intentions, such as wanting to provide a family vacation, don't justify objectively evil actions, such as robbing a bank to do it. In other words, the ends (good intentions) don't justify the means (objectively bad acts). Good decision making leads to right choices.

Throughout history, wicked societies have committed atrocities against babies. Many people today think we have legal abortion because we are enlightened and progressive, and we have advanced medicine. No! Like previous wicked civilization, we sanction abortion because we have degenerated morally. It's an old story just made new.
