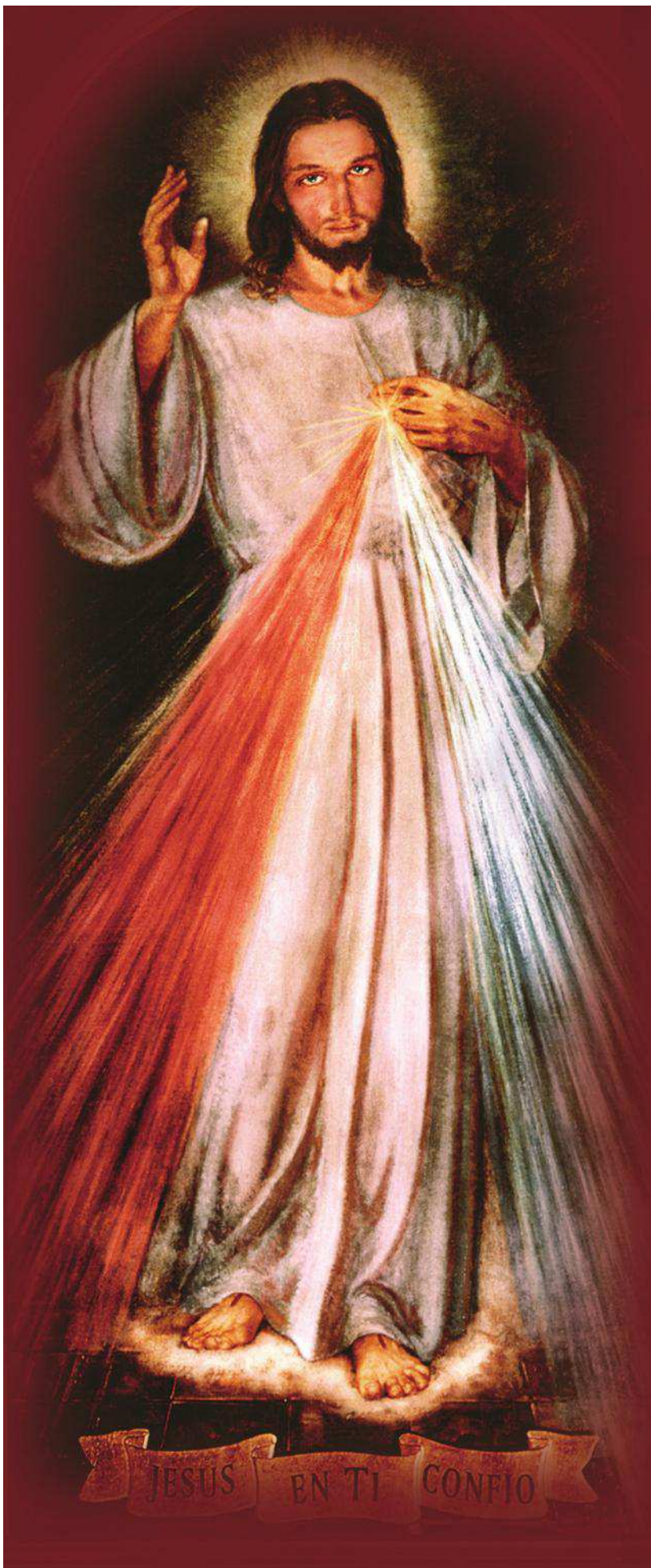

MARRIAGES

To be married at IHM either the prospective bride or groom must be an individually registered, supporting member of the parish for at least one year prior to the first meeting with the priest.
