One of the IHM parishioners recently commented on seeing many new faces in the congregation. "I had an inspiration about the need for new faces and new energy in some of the organizations that are part of our Catholic community."

Last week we discussed ways you can help in the IHM parish itself. Another way you can offer your talents in our Catholic community, is to join KNOX COUNTY RIGHT TO LIFE - KCRL.

Members of Knox County Right to Life not only come from the three Catholic parishes, but also from churches of all denominations throughout the community. KCRL provides activities that support the local Women's Pregnancy Center, provides help for agencies throughout the area that support women in crisis pregnancy. They organize prayer activities such as the annual Interdenominational Prayer Service & weekly trips to pray in front of abortion facilities as well as the annual Life Chain It publishes a quarterly newsletter to promote activity and information. KCRL has an annual pancake breakfast and bake sale with the cooperation of the Knights of Columbus who provide the space and the breakfast preparation. The breakfast is an opportunity for fellowship and sharing of information about pro-life issues. It also sponsors an annual Festival of Life featuring nationally known Pro-Life advocates. Another part of the festival is the Pastors' Dinner that provides a pro-life fellowship forum for all pro-life pastors in the community. KCRL supports the prolife club at Galesburg High School and the Joshua Camp to provide tools for young people to deal with the Culture of Death that permeates their world. Volunteers are needed in every activity of Knox County Right to Life.

Many of the current leaders of KCRL have been involved since the 70's and are in their 70's. We have some new faces and really could use some more.... The high school kids are a real inspiration.


