

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

You may notice a lot of new things happening on the Church property. All of the projects that are being done are making our School and Church property more appealing to the neighborhood. The work that you see being done is almost completely volunteer and in a number of situations the volunteers are also supplying materials as well. We are very blessed to have members of the parish working so hard on improvements to our property. These improvements will attract people and companies to rent our facilities to provide needed revenue for St. Francis to stay open and viable.

I would love to identify the volunteers who I am dependent upon for these projects being completed. However, a number of them refuse to allow their names to be mentioned and I don't want to give praise to one and not another. If you know any of these guys yourself, feel free to thank them for their charity and support. If you feel called or moved to help us during the week you could just drive by and visit or lend a hand. All are welcome and sometimes lunch is free.

The projects that we are working on are numerous. Often we have several projects going at the same time. Today the rod-iron fence in front of school will be completed and the planter in front of the parish hall will be our focus of attention. Sometimes I will participate in the projects and at other times I'm about other things that need my attention. We will be painting, rebuilding window frames in the school, repairing roofs and just cleaning and repairing. There is always work that needs to be done and we enjoy the company of others, especially those who will speak Spanish to Padre. Practicar mucho es muy importante para mi.

Just for your information. The projects we are doing have cost us a fraction of what they cost normally. We saved approximately \$25,000.00 on the rod-iron fence because of the volunteers work and charity. I honestly do not know how much the volunteers gave financially to this project but look at the difference.

I ask Jesus Christ our Savior and Our Blessed Mother to protect and bless all the friends and families of our Brothers and Sisters who have made these projects possible. I pray that the Blessed Mother keep me here at St. Francis many more years.

Para su información. Los proyectos que estamos nos han costado una fracción de lo que cuestan normalmente. Honestamente no se cuento los voluntarios dieron financieramente a este proyecto pero mira la diferencia. Pido a Jesucristo nuestro Señor y a nuestra Santísima Madre que proteja y bendiga a todos los amigos y familiares de nuestros hermanos y hermanas que han hecho posible estos proyectos. One of the wonderful things about vacations is the time we spend two or three weeks afterward savoring the experience, sharing vacation photos and memories with our family and friends. 


