I Made a Mistake: Mass Intentions

I spoke with the Canon Lawyer of the diocese regarding the number of Mass intentions per Mass. Even though Canon Law states, there should only be one Mass intention per Mass, there are other extenuating circumstances that apply here in the United States. The Bishop may give permission to allow more intentions per Mass. Bishop Sheehan has given this dispensation to all the parishes in the Archdiocese of Santa Fe because of the number of intentions people ask to have celebrated. He allows there to be as many as 3 intentions per Mass celebrated. Therefore we are happy to add intentions to all future Mass Celebrations for those who would like to have a Mass celebrated for a special intention. Remember we celebrate the Eucharist (Mass) every Morning at 8:00 a.m.

Please except my apology for changing things without checking with the Bishops office first.

With this great gift comes a responsibility: to respond to the call with our own distinctive voice, to take time to discern exactly what our call is, to determine precisely what the will of the Father is for each of us.

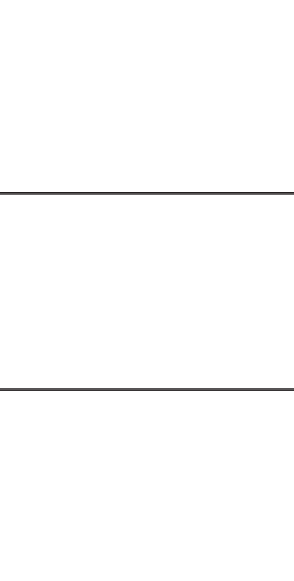
