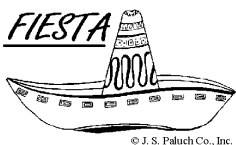
**Statement: The Most Reverend John C. Wester
Archbishop of Santa Fe on the Supreme Court of the
United States Decision on Same-sex Marriage**

The Supreme Court of the United States decided state marriage bans are unconstitutional, meaning all states will perform and recognize same-sex marriage. This decision, though significant, does not conclude debate over the definition of marriage; we would like to affirm the following pastoral response. As Catholics, we seek to uphold our traditional belief in marriage as a sacrament, a well-established and divinely revealed covenant between one man and one woman, a permanent and exclusive bond meant to provide a nurturing environment for children and the fundamental building block to a just society. At the same time, we respect the dignity of all persons, not wishing to undermine their pursuit of happiness but only to preserve and defend the gift of marriage as divinely revealed in scripture and in natural law. Although we respectfully disagree with those who would define marriage otherwise, we firmly hold that all persons are loved by our compassionate God and deserve the respect and dignity that is inherently theirs as human beings. We acknowledge the right of our nation's highest court to provide for a well ordered society by establishing laws that protect the common good and safeguard the civil and contractual rights and privileges of its citizens. At the same time, we urge our lawmakers and judges to respect those institutions that are beyond state and federal jurisdiction, institutions such as sacramental marriage that transcend civil law and whose origins precede the existence of the state and go beyond its competence.

**Declaración: Reverendísimo John C. Wester, Arzobispo de
Santa Fe sobre la decisión del Tribunal Supremo de los Esta-
dos Unidos con respecto al matrimonio entre personas del
mismo sexo.**

La Corte Suprema de los Estados Unidos decidió que las prohibiciones matrimoniales estatales son inconstitucionales, es decir, que ahora todos los estados llevarán a cabo y reconocerán el matrimonio entre personas del mismo sexo. Esta decisión, aunque significativa, no concluye el debate sobre la definición del matrimonio; nos gustaría afirmar la siguiente respuesta pastoral: Como católicos, buscamos mantener nuestra creencia tradicional en el matrimonio como un sacramento, un bien establecido y divinamente revelado pacto entre un hombre y una mujer, una unión permanente y exclusiva cuya intención es proporcionar un entorno enriquecedor para los niños y ser la piedra angular para una sociedad justa. Al mismo tiempo, respetamos la dignidad de todas las personas y no deseamos socavar su búsqueda de la felicidad, sino solamente preservar y defender el don del matrimonio como fue divinamente revelado en las escrituras y en la ley natural. Aunque respetuosamente estamos en desacuerdo con quienes definen el matrimonio de otra manera, sostenemos firmemente que todas las personas son amadas por nuestro Dios compasivo y merecen el respeto y la dignidad que como seres humanos les pertenece. Reconocemos el derecho del tribunal supremo de la nación de ser responsable de una sociedad bien ordenada estableciendo leyes que protejan el bien común y salvaguarden los derechos y privilegios civiles y contractuales de sus ciudadanos. Al mismo tiempo, instamos a nuestros legisladores y jueces a respetar las instituciones que están más allá de la jurisdicción estatal y federal, instituciones como el matrimonio sacramental que trasciende la ley civil y cuyos orígenes preceden a la existencia del estado y van más allá de su competencia.
