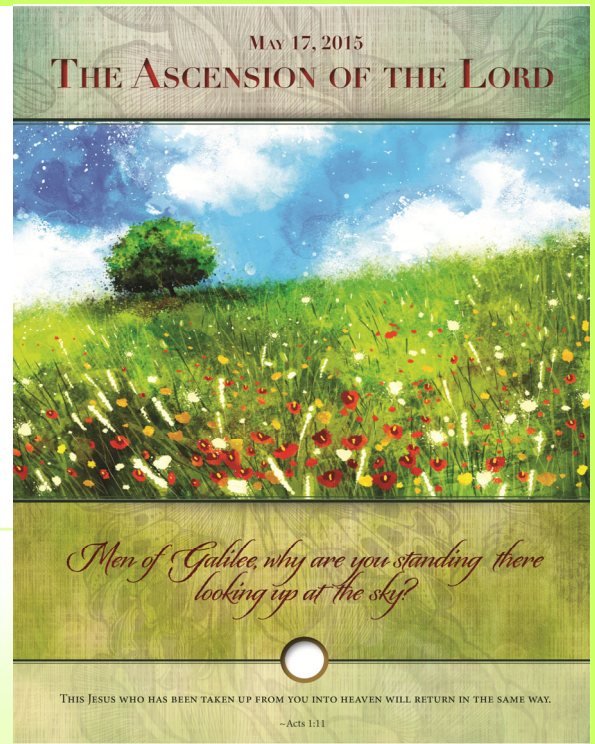

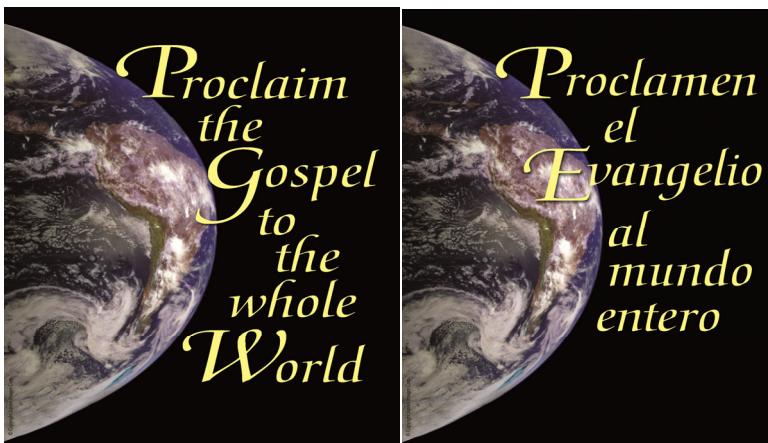

Basic Principles of Catholic Social Teaching

The Church's teaching on social justice guides us in living the holiness and building a just society.

These principles are:

1. All human life is sacred. The basic equality of all people flows from their dignity as human persons and the rights that flow from that dignity.
2. The human person is the principle, the object, and the subject of every social group.
3. The human person has been created by God to belong to and to participate in a family and other social communities.
4. Respect for the rights of people flows from their dignity as persons. Society and all social organizations must promote virtue and protect human life and human rights and guarantee the conditions that promote the exercise of freedom.
5. Political communities and public authority are based on human nature. They belong to an order established by God.
6. All human authority must be used for the common good of society.
7. The common good of society consists of respect for and promotion of the fundamental rights of the human person; the just development of material and spiritual goods of society; and the peace and safety of all people.
8. We need to work to eliminate the sinful inequalities that exist between peoples and for the improvement of the living conditions of people. The needs of the poor and vulnerable have priority.
9. We are one human and global family. We are to share our spiritual blessings, even more than our material blessings.

Principios Básicos de la DOCTRINA SOCIAL CATOLICA

La enseñanza de la Iglesia de la justicia social nos guía a vivir vidas de santidad y a construir una sociedad justa.

Estos son los principios:

1. Toda vida humana es sagrada. La igualdad básica de todas las personas fluye de su dignidad de seres humanos y de los derechos que surgen de esa dignidad.
2. La persona humana es el principio, el objeto y sujeto de cada grupo social.
3. La persona humana ha sido creada por Dios para pertenecer y para participar en una familia y en otras comunidades sociales.
4. El respeto por los derechos de los demás surge de su dignidad como personas. La sociedad y todas las organizaciones sociales deben promover la virtud y proteger la vida humana y los derechos humanos y garantizar las condiciones que promuevan el ejercicio de la libertad.
5. Las comunidades políticas y la autoridad pública están basadas en la naturaleza humana. Pertenecen a un orden establecido por Dios.
6. Toda autoridad humana debe ser usada para el bien común de la sociedad.
7. El bien común de la sociedad consiste en el respeto y la promoción de los derechos fundamentales de la persona humana, del justo desarrollo de los bienes materiales y espirituales de la sociedad y de la paz y seguridad de todos los pueblos.
8. Debemos trabajar para eliminar las desigualdades e iniquidades que existen entre las personas y para mejorar las condiciones de vida de los pueblos. Las necesidades de los pobres y vulnerables tienen prioridad.
9. Somos una familia humana y global. Debemos compartir nuestras bendiciones espirituales aun más que nuestras bendiciones materiales.

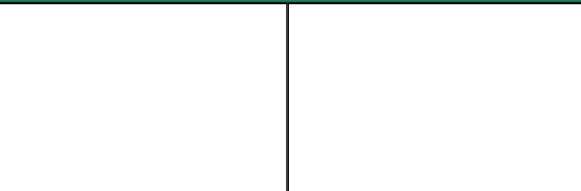
