



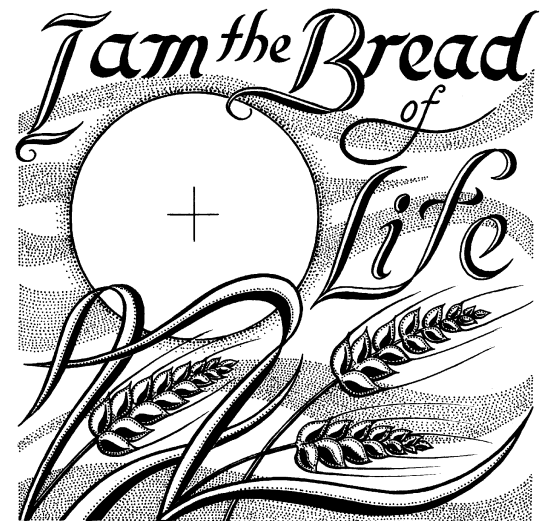

Next Week's Gospel: John 6:51-58

Gospel Reflection: Once again Jesus the Teacher is having a hard time getting through to His listeners. They resist His teaching that He is the living bread from heaven. When they continue to object, Jesus assures them that His flesh is real food and His blood is real drink. If they do not "feed on" Him, they will have no life in them. We are blessed because we can share the Living Bread at every Eucharist. As we satisfy our spiritual hunger, we remember those who hunger for food, shelter, friendship, or faith. We consider how we can respond to the hungers of the world.

Discussion Points for Gospel: What do you remember about your First Communion? How do you think receiving the Body and Blood of Jesus makes a difference in your life?
