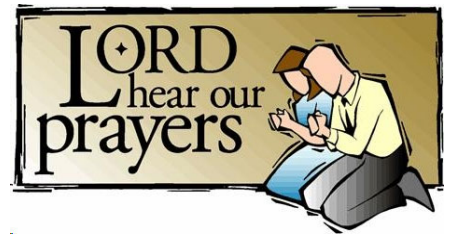

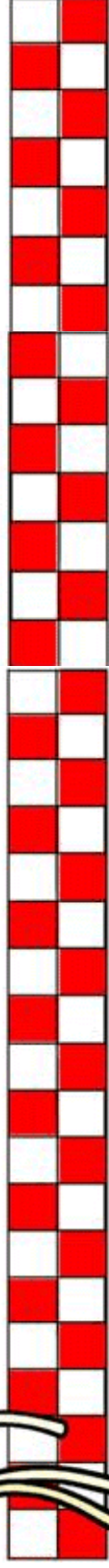
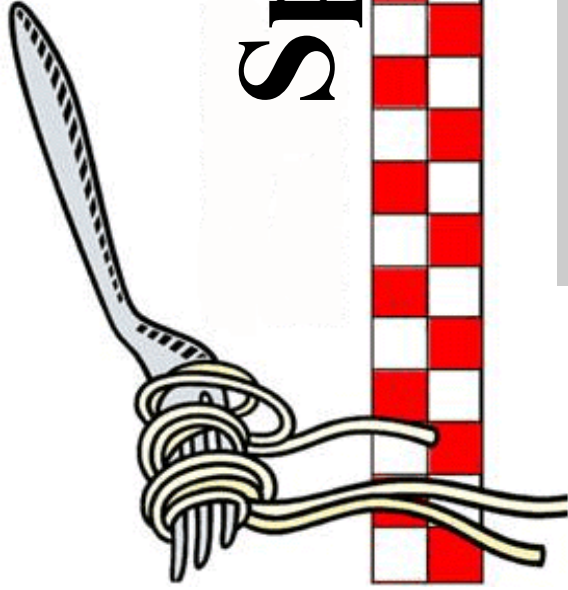
Lord, You invite all who are burdened to come to You. Allow your healing hand to heal those in need.

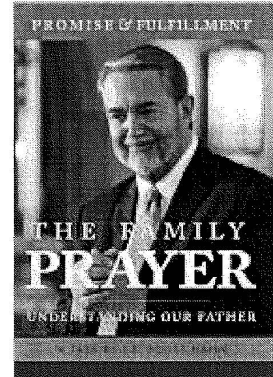

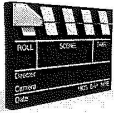

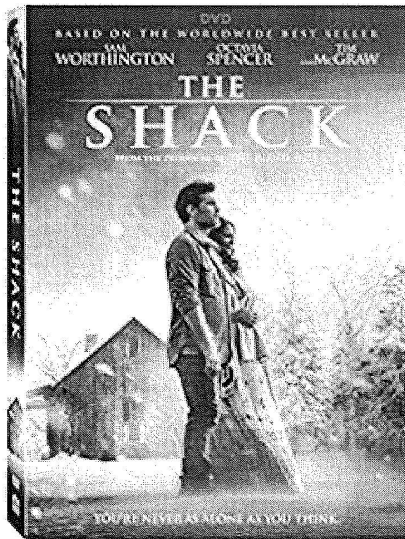

The Shack



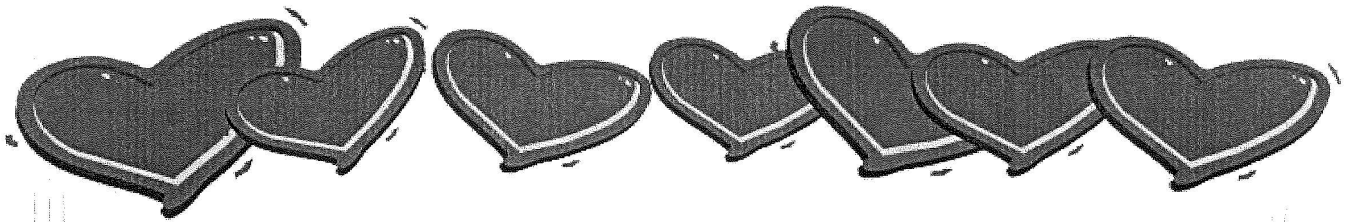
