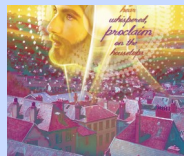

**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:** The Sacrament of Baptism is administered monthly. Arrangements are made in advance at the Rectory. Sponsors must provide proof of eligibility by a letter from their respective pastors, and must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Communion, and Confirmation. Parents attend a Pre-Jordan meeting prior to Baptism, which is arranged at a mutually convenient time.

**SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:** Arrangements must be made with the pastor at least six months before the date of the wedding. Pre-Cana instructions are required. Couples rather than parents or wedding coordinators should contact the church. If either party was previously married, an annulment must be granted prior to the selection of a future wedding date.

**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK**

Dear Parishioners:

We have come face-to-face with “Murphy’s Law” once again, **whatever can go wrong... will go wrong!** Just this past week when the construction team was surveying the ground and using sonar/ x-ray to find pipes for the geothermal system, sewage and water supply, they discovered that the electrical supply goes right through the area they intend to dig for the new elevator. Therefore, they will now have to move the electrical supply conduit to a new location. As a result, there will be the necessity to dig a trench going directly from the generator to the geothermal room in the school. This will impact the parking situation for our main lot. They already had a very tight window to do the work during the summer months while the school children are out of class. Ray Collins, the architects, and the General Contractor. Recognizing that anything that may pop up on a Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday may have to be handled through a simple announcement at the end of Mass. We pray daily for smooth sailing in the days ahead, yet, at the same time remain vigilant that there could be unexpected delays or inconveniences as they renovate the old convent and build the new elevator for our catholic school. Have a Blessed week ahead... May you stay cool in this summer heat...and May the Lord watch over and protect you and your family.

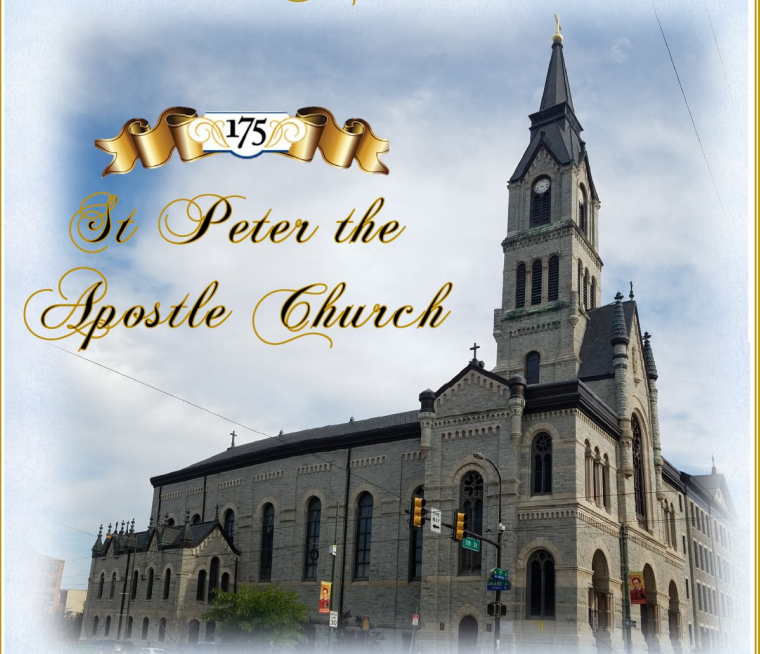
