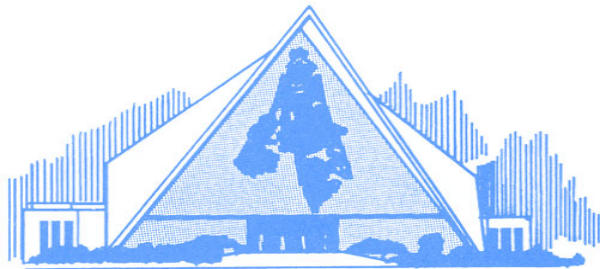
Shrine (1963) + Co-Cathedral Reno/Las Vegas (1976)

ON ASH WEDNESDAY HELP CATHOLIC CHARITIES

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On March 5, 2014 we begin our Forty Days of Lent. For some, it is a time of reflection and prayer. Others may donate to charity in the tradition of almsgiving. For many though, the tradition of fasting is the chosen means of honoring their faith. Though the paths we take through the Lenten season may differ, we all embark on the same spiritual journey and we all share in the same goal; to reaffirm our commitment to Christ and to our fellow man.

In reaffirming these commitments, I am reminded of a passage by the prophet Isaiah, who said that true fasting is, "...sharing your bread with the hungry, sheltering the oppressed and the homeless: clothing the naked when you see them, and not turning your back on your own" Is 58:6-7.

We should consider then that fasting is not just a physical act, but a *spiritual* one. It is the emptying of sin in our hearts and of moral weakness in our minds. It is a baptismal renewal achieved through the giving of ourselves to God and to each other. Only by passing through this emptiness do we become spiritually full again.

When we observe someone who is suffering or in need, we should remember that the person we are looking at is not really a stranger. As we all are sown from the same seed, what we are seeing is ourselves but with a different face. We are witnessing a manifestation of Christ in another form. So when we see those who are hungry and homeless, we should not turn our back. We should recognize, as Isaiah wisely states, that these are our own.

In keeping with that wisdom, I ask you to include Catholic Charities of Southern Nevada as part of your Lenten Observance. If you pray, please pray for all those Catholic Charities humbly serves. If you fast, please consider donating your unused food to their food pantry. If you give alms, please remember the Annual Ash Wednesday Collection is a wonderful opportunity to assist in the work of our Church for our brothers and sisters in need.

This manifestation of God's love for all people is made possible by your devotion and generosity. Your kindness creates the daily miracles that allow the most vulnerable among us to see the face of Christ. I pray that this Lent, in your own way, you will all serve as shepherds to guide those in need into the Paschal mysteries we celebrate at Easter and God's divine light.

ASH WEDNESDAY - LENT BEGINS

The Holy Season of Lent begins this Wednesday, March 5. If possible begin Lent by coming to Mass, receiving Holy Communion and the imposition of blessed ashes. We will have three Masses on Ash Wednesday: **8:00am, 12:10pm & 5:00pm**

LAWS OF FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Catholics between 21 and 59 years of age are to FAST on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these 2 days meals are to be smaller and less expensive. On Ash Wednesday and ALL the FRIDAYS of Lent, Catholics are to ABSTAIN from meat. Some alternatives are fish, cheese, peanut butter & jelly and eggs are great, etc. These meals are to be less expensive than usual.

THE PURPOSE

of fasting, abstinence, penance, giving things up, good deeds, extra prayers and Masses, etc. is to help us become more Christ-like, to help us become better people. The money saved from less expensive meals and not buying what we have given up should be donated to helping the poor. The Catholic Charities, Bishops Overseas Appeal and the Good Friday collections are important parts of our Lenten almsgiving - important opportunities to help the poor.
