#### **Mission Statement**

Our Lady of Grace, founded in 1910 as an Italian ethnic parish, is now a territorial parish of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Greensburg to which all people are welcome. The responsibility of each member of Our Lady of Grace is to hear the Word of God and live it by sharing in worship, especially at Eucharist; by nurturing our Catholic faith through formation and prayer; by reaching out to identify and serve the needs of our parish and the community; and by welcoming others into our faith community. Through our actions, we strive to share, and to encourage others to share, in the fullness of God's kingdom.

#### **Baptisms**

By appointment only. Please call the parish office at least four months in advance of the birth. A class for parents is required to reflect on the meaning of the sacrament, to review the ceremony, and to highlight the importance of the family's commitment to practicing the Catholic Faith.

#### Sponsorship Forms

Forms for our members to serve as sponsors for Baptism and Confirmation must be filled out in person at the Parish Office. To serve as a sponsor, you must be at least 16 years old and a practicing Catholic who has received Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. If you are married, it must be within the guidelines of the Catholic Church. Please call the Parish Office to make an appointment to fill out the form.

#### Weddings

Please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance. Do not set a date until you have contacted the parish priest. Pre-marriage preparation classes are required and are available in a couple of forms.

Next Sunday, October 23, is World Mission Sunday. Our second collection on October 22-23 will be for World Missions. In keeping with the Jubilee Year of Mercy, the theme for this year's celebration of World Mission Sunday is "Mercy Changes the World!" Every year, for the past 90 years. we have been reminded on the next to the last Sunday of October, that we are a part of a Church that was founded for the proclamation of the Good News of Jesus Christ. On World Mission Sunday our prayers, gifts, and sacrifices are united with the prayers, gifts, and sacrifices of other Catholics throughout the world. We can be merciful agents of change as we support the work of missionaries serving in 1,111 mission dioceses, each of which is counting on our support and help in providing service and spiritual comfort for the poorest and most vulnerable; sanctifying them with the Sacraments; and offering them the Lord's hope, peace, and mercy. Please keep the Missions in your prayers and be generous in next week's collection for the missions.
