#### **Baptisms**

By appointment only. Please call the parish office at least four months in advance of the birth. A class for parents is required to reflect on the meaning of the sacrament, to review the ceremony, and to highlight the importance of the family's commitment to practicing the Catholic Faith.

#### Sponsorship Forms

Forms for our members to serve as sponsors for Baptism and Confirmation must be filled out in person at the Parish Office. To serve as a sponsor, you must be at least 16 years old and a practicing Catholic who has received Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. If you are married, it must be within the guidelines of the Catholic Church. Please call the Parish Office to make an appointment to fill out the form.

#### Weddings

Please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance.

Do not set a date until you have contacted the parish priest. Pre-marriage preparation classes are required and are available in a couple of forms.

Catholic-Lutheran Joint Commemoration of the Reformation ~ Bishop Edward C. Malesic will preside at "An Evening of Witness and Thanksgiving" on Thursday, June 29, at 7 p.m. at St. Kilian Catholic Church in Cranberry Township. Refreshments and fellowship will follow the service. This event is part of "From Conflict to Communion: Together in Hope," the theme of the regional observance of the 500th anniversary of the Reformation.

First Saturday Mass and devotions at Diocesan Heritage Center ~ In observance of the centennial anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima, the Diocesan Heritage Center will host a series of First Saturday Masses and devotions at the Bishop Connare Center on July 1, Aug. 5, Sept. 2 and Oct. 7. The day will begin with Mass in the St. Joseph Chapel at 9 a.m. and be followed by recitation of the rosary. The Center's exhibit "Petals of Love — the Rosary in Art and Faith" will be open after the devotion and from 1-4 p.m. on those Saturdays, in addition to the exhibit's regular hours from 1-4 p.m. Thursdays.

Diocesan Youth Honors ~ Each year the Diocese of Greensburg recognizes graduating high school seniors whose Catholic faith has been lived in their personal life, in their relationships, and in their service to the parish, the community, and the Diocese. Their Catholic life has been and can continue to be an example to other young men and women in our community of faith. Our parish congratulates these high school graduates who will receive the Diocesan Parish Youth Honors: Abigail Blend, Tessa Florek, and Abigail Hutchins. Bishop Edward C. Malesic will celebrate a Eucharistic Liturgy to recognize these youth at Blessed Sacrament Cathedral, Greensburg, Sunday, July 9, at 3 p.m. A reception will follow the Mass. We are grateful to these high school graduates of our parish for being examples of Catholic leadership, and we congratulate them on receiving this recognition by our Diocese.
