## **Mission Statement**

Our Lady of Grace, founded in 1910 as an Italian ethnic parish, is now a territorial parish of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Greensburg to which all people are welcome. The responsibility of each member of Our Lady of Grace is to hear the Word of God and live it by sharing in worship, especially at Eucharist; by nurturing our Catholic faith through formation and prayer; by reaching out to identify and serve the needs of our parish and the community; and by welcoming others into our faith community. Through our actions, we strive to share, and to encourage others to share, in the fullness of God's kingdom.

#### **Baptisms**

By appointment only. Please call the parish office at least four months in advance of the birth. A class for parents is required to reflect on the meaning of the sacrament, to review the ceremony, and to highlight the importance of the family's commitment to practicing the Catholic Faith.

#### **Sponsorship Forms**

Forms for our members to serve as sponsors for Baptism and Confirmation must be filled out in person at the Parish Office. To serve as a sponsor, you must be at least 16 years old and a practicing Catholic who has received Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. If you are married, it must be within the guidelines of the Catholic Church. Please call the Parish Office to make an appointment to fill out the form.

#### Weddings

Please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance.

Do not set a date until you have contacted the parish priest. Pre-marriage preparation classes are required and are available in a couple of forms.

#### Bishop Malesic to lead drug education and prayer service evenings ~

In his recently released Pastoral Letter on the current drug abuse crisis, Bishop Edward C. Malesic poses the question that all of us have been asking: "What can we do about it?" In response to that question, he challenges us as Catholics to do the two things that we do best — **Pray and Teach!** 

So, on Thursday, August 3, Our Lady of Grace Church will be hosting one of the seven Summer Diocesan Drug Education and Prayer Service Evenings as part of the diocesan response that Bishop Malesic announced in "A Pastoral Letter on the Drug Abuse Crisis: From Death and Despair to Life and Hope." The session will begin at 7 p.m. and is open to the public. There will be an educational presentation about the opioid epidemic in the region, a questionand-answer session in Albanese Hall; a prayer service led by Bishop Malesic in the Church at 8 p.m.; concluding with refreshments at 8:30 p.m.

The other evenings are scheduled for Wednesday, Aug. 2, St. Joseph Parish, Uniontown; Tuesday, Aug. 8, St. Mary, Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish, Kittanning; Thursday, Aug. 10, Mary, Queen of Apostles School, Greenwald Site, New Kensington; and Wednesday, Aug. 16, St. Thomas More University Parish, Indiana.

I encourage you to make every effort – and invite your friends, co-workers, and acquaintances to come and gather to learn and pray – to rally around this initiative of our Diocesan Bishop. With God's divine inspiration, guidance, wisdom, and courage we can confront and defeat this drug crisis while proclaiming our desire to help and heal those affected by an opioid addiction.

May our church bring to those affected by and entangled in the web of addiction our Lord's renewed hope and healing love.
