Baptisms

By appointment only. Please call the parish office at least four months in advance of the birth. A class for parents is required to reflect on the meaning of the sacrament, to review the ceremony, and to highlight the importance of the family's commitment to practicing the Catholic Faith.

Sponsorship Forms

Forms for our members to serve as sponsors for Baptism and Confirmation must be filled out in person at the Parish Office. To serve as a sponsor, you must be at least 16 years old and a practicing Catholic who has received Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. If you are married, it must be within the guidelines of the Catholic Church. Please call the Parish Office to make an appointment to fill out the form.

Weddings

Please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance.

Do not set a date until you have contacted the parish priest. Pre-marriage preparation classes are required and are available in a couple of forms.

Bishop Malesic to lead drug education and prayer service evenings ~ In his recently released Pastoral Letter on the current drug abuse crisis, Bishop Edward C. Malesic poses the question that all of us have been asking: "What can we do about it?" In response to that question, he challenges us as Catholics to do the two things that we do best – **Pray and Teach!** So, on Thursday, August 3, Our Lady of Grace Church will be hosting one of the seven Summer Diocesan Drug Education and Prayer Service evenings as part of the diocesan response that Bishop Malesic announced in "A Pastoral Letter on the Drug Abuse Crisis: From Death and Despair to Life and Hope." The session will begin at 7 p.m. and is open to the public. There will be an educational presentation about the opioid epidemic in the region; a question-and-answer session in Albanese Hall; a prayer service led by Bishop Malesic in the Church at 8 p.m.; concluding with refreshments at 8:30 p.m.

Bishop Malesic will celebrate Mass and host a luncheon for members of the Our Lady of the Assumption Legacy Society, August 10, at noon, at the Bishop Connare Center. James Monteverde, founder of The Monteverde Group, a firm providing service in estate planning and financial counseling, will be the guest speaker. This special society provides an opportunity for benefactors to make their philanthropy a perpetual legacy for themselves and an example for their families to follow. It also creates a means of support to make our parishes and ministries stronger, sustainable and better equipped to spread the Gospel and the love of Jesus Christ for generations to come.
