Mission Statement

Our Lady of Grace, founded in 1910 as an Italian ethnic parish, is now a territorial parish of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Greensburg to which all people are welcome. Baptisms

By appointment only. Please call the parish office at least four months in advance of the birth. A class for parents is required to reflect on the meaning of the sacrament, to review the ceremony, and to highlight the importance of the family's commitment to practicing the Catholic Faith.

Sponsorship Forms

Forms for our members to serve as sponsors for Baptism and Confirmation must be filled out in person at the Parish Office. To serve as a sponsor, you must be at least 16 years old and a practicing Catholic who has received Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. If you are married, it must be within the guidelines of the Catholic Church. Please call the Parish Office to make an appointment to fill out the form.

Weddings

Please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance.

Do not set a date until you have contacted the parish priest. Pre-marriage preparation classes are required and are available in a couple of forms. Church Roof Project Update ~ Our parish is indebted to the many parishioners who have fulfilled their sacrificial pledge to the 2017 DLA. As you recall, our parish case statement was to help fund the costs associated with the capital repair or replacement of certain sections of our church roof. To date, the total amount refunded to the parish from the 2017 DLA is approximately \$25,000. These funds have allowed us to proceed with this much-needed roof repair project.

After soliciting, reviewing, and analyzing bids, our parish has selected CTS Construction of New Stanton to repair our church's metal and flat roofs. The scope of this work will include grinding and repairing the rust spots on the seams of the metal roof, then coating the entire metal roof (approx. 8,750 sq. ft.) with Gaco Flex Silicone. In addition, all of the flat roofs (approx. 5,300 sq. ft.) will be removed and replaced with a high quality Gen Flex EDPM Rubber roofing. Both the metal and flat roofs will carry a 20-year warranty. The cost of this project is a little over \$100,000 and is being included in the parish budget for the 2017-2018 fiscal year. Our parish is relying on the continued generosity of our parishioners to meet the expense for this project that exceeds our income from the 2017 DLA by about \$75,000. I realize that many of you make personal sacrifices in order to maintain your current level of support; however, I would like to ask that you consider making a one-time contribution toward our roof repair and replacement project. If you would like to do so, you can include your gift in your Sunday offertory envelope. Your sacrificial financial support of our parish not only allows us to continue the good work of ministry and service in the name of Christ, but also to keep our church and parish buildings in good repair.

Nothing to Fear ~ A rabbi was asked why God sends trials and troubles into human lives. "Because God gets lonely for his people" was the reply. There is some resonance with this wisdom in today's Gospel, as Jesus makes his disciples get into a boat without him and goes off alone while they venture into stormy waters. Of course, neither Jews nor Christians believe that the Almighty plays this sort of whimsical game with them, but there is some truth in the statement that we don't turn to God for saving help until we're in a bind. Peter's role today, as it is throughout the New Testament, is to be a sign or to represent each member of the church and the whole church. Our story is the tale told about Peter's faith today. What can bolster our faith is that even when Christ calls us to face bravely the tempests of life, if we are walking through them with our eyes fixed on him in faith, we have nothing to fear. Even when we falter or sink, simply crying "Lord, save me!" is enough to help us know the steady grasp of God's hand. 
